MADISON, WIS -- UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN'S INDOOR TRACK TEAM UTILIZED DOUBLE VICTORIES BY SOPHOMORE DON VANDREY IN THE MILE AND 880 AND SENIOR GLENN DICK IN THE LONG AND TRIPLE JUMPS, AN ALL-AROUND FIELD EVENT PERFORMANCE BY SENIOR TON THIES, AND A RECORD-BREAKING 1,000 YARD RUN BY SOPHOMORE MARK WINZENRIED TO GAIN AN 86-63 VICTORY OVER MICHIGAN STATE HERE SATURDAY AFTERNOON IN A DUAL MEET THAT RAW THE BADGERS UNBEATEN STRING TO NINE STRAIGHT OVER THE PAST TWO SEASONS.

VANDREY, FROM VALPARAISO, IND., RAN HIS FASTEST MILE THIS YEAR IN 4:06.2 IN TURNING BACK THE CHALLENGE OF MICHIGAN STATE'S KIN HARTMAN WHO WAS SECOND IN 4:08.7. DON CAME BACK LATER IN THE AFTERNOON AND COASTED TO A HALF-MILE VICTORY IN 1:55.1.

GLENN DICK EASILY OUTCLASSED HIS COMPETITION IN WINNING THE LONG JUMP IN 23 FEET 2 3/4 INCHES AND THE TRIPLE JUMP IN 44 FEET THREE INCHES.

Tom Thies, AN OCONOMOWOG SENIOR WHO CAME TO WISCONSIN WITHOUT A SCHOLARSHIP COMPETED IN FOUR FIELD EVENTS AND SCORED TEN POINTS TO MATCH DICK<sup>9</sup> B CONTRIBUTION TO A WISCONSIN<sup>9</sup> 32-12 SCORING EDGE IN THE FIELD EVENTS. Thies won the pole vault with his career best of 15 FEET 4 INCHES; PLACED SECOND IN THE HIGH JUMP AT 5 FEET 6 INCHES; AND TOOK THIRD PLACE IN THE LONG AND TRIPLE JUMPS.

WINZENRIED SET AN EVEN PACE ALL THE WAY EN ROUTE TO MATCHING THE FASTEST 1,000 YARD RUN TIME EVER TURNED IN BY A BIG TEN UNDER-GRADUATE STUDENT. HIS TIME OF 2:07.8 MATCHED THE TIME RAY ARRINGTON TURNED IN TWO YEARS AGO IN WINNING THE NCAA 1,000 YARD RUN IN DETROIT AS A SOPHOMORE.

THE MONROE, WISCONSIN NATIVE -- WHO HAS A 1:49.9 HALF-MILE TO HIB CREDIT THIS YEAR -- RAN THE 220 IN 27 SECONDS; THE 440 IN 55 SECONDS; THE 660 IN 1:23; THE 880 IN 1:52, AND COVERED THE FINAL 120 YARDS IN 15.8 BECONDS IN BREAKING THE BADGER SCHOOL MARK OF 2:08.5 SET BY ARRINGTON IN 55 AGE A FLOSH MANON. ADD - 1 WISCONSIN INDOOR TRACK SUMMARY

SENIOR MURDLER PAT MURPHY, LACROSSE, MADE HIS VARSIVY DEBUT - HE TRANSFERRED HERE FROM TENNESSEE - AND WON THE 70 YARD HIGH HURDLES IN 8.5 SECS., AND PLACED SECOND IN THE 70 YARD LOWS IN 8.1 SECS., BEHIND STATE'S WAYNE HARTWICK WHO WAS CLOCKED IN EIGHT SECONDS EVEN.

MICHIGAN STATE SENIOR BILL WEHRWEIN, WHO HAS A 1:09.9 600 YARD RUN TO HIS CREDIT THIS YEAR, MOVED DOWN TO WIN THE 300 AND 440 YARD EVENTS AND HE ANCHORED STATE'S WINNING RELAY TEAM IN 3:16.2. HE WON THE 300 YARD DASH IN 31.3 SECS., AND THE 440 YARD RUN IN 48.6 SECS.

Two MILER KEN LEONOWICZ OF THE SPARTANS WON HIS SPECIALTY IN 9:04.8 WITH A BURST OF SPEED ON THE FINAL LAP TO NIP BRANCH BRADY OF THE BADGERS WHO POSTED HIS SEASON'S BEST OF 9:06.5. SOPHOMORE DEAN MARTELL, SOMERSET, WIS., PLACED THIRD WITH HIS CAREER BEST OF 9:11.5.

OTHER BADGER WINNERS WERE BOB HAWKE IN THE SHOT PUT AT 53 FEET 10 INCHES, AND BRAD HANSON IN THE 600 YARD RUN WITH A CAREER BEST 1:11,5. HE STEPPED OUT TO AN EARLY LEAD AND OUTRACED STATE'S PAT WILSON TO THE TAPE WITH A 15 YARD FINAL ADVANTAGE.
