His times tonight were 4 min-utes 8 seconds for the mile (compared with last night's 4:30.4) and 8:49.8 (compared with 8:34.0). Jim Ryun, world record-holder in the mile, did not complete in his specialty, but finished second in the 880 to Chris Fisher of Australia be-

Milburn, in his second pro race, became co-holder of the 60-yard high hurdles record by edging Leon Coleman with a clocking of 6.9 seconds.
