

2d Double In 2 Nights For Jipcho

BALTIMORE, Feb. 16 (UPI) —Ben Jipcho of Kenya posted a double victory in distant events for the second straight night and Rod Milburn equaled an indoor hurdles record tonight in the International Track Association's second meet the season.

The 30-year-old Jipcho beat Keith Munson and Jerome Howe in the one-mile run after breezing to victory over George Young in the two-mile.

Jipcho swept the same events in his pro and indoor debuts when the I.T.A. opened in Uniondale, L. I., last night. His times tonight were 4 minutes 8 seconds for the mile (compared with last night's 4:30.4) and 8:49.8 (compared with 8:34.0).

Jim Ryun, world record-holder in the mile, did not complete in his specialty, but finished second in the 880 to Chris Fisher of Australia before 4,758 fans.

Milburn, in his second pro race, became co-holder of the 60-yard high hurdles record by edging Leon Coleman with a clocking of 6.9 seconds. Coleman set the mark in Salt Lake City last may, along with Paul Gibson. The world indoor mark is 6.8.

The pole vault was won by Buddy Williamson at 17 feet. Steve Smith snapped his pole on his first try, then failed three times at 17 feet with a new pole.
