

Matson, Carlos Feature

MODESTO — Randy Matson was named Athlete of the Meet for an outstanding shot put series and former San Jose State star John Carlos captured both dashes to highlight the annual California Relays Classic Saturday.

Matson, world record holder at 8-1 $\frac{1}{2}$, won the shot at

69-8 and had other puts of 69-2 $\frac{3}{4}$ and 68-11 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Carlos won the 100 meters in 10.0 with aiding wind of 6.9, and had that same time in winning his qualifying heat earlier in the day, also with an aiding wind.

Jaunty John came back late in the evening to claim the 220-yard dash in 20.6 with Willie Turner of Oregon State second in 20.7.

Outstanding marks were registered in the high jump and pole vault which didn't finish until 90 minutes after the final track event.

Bill Elliott, former University of Texas star now competing for Pacific Coast Club, and Renaldo Brown, competing unattached, both cleared 7-3 $\frac{1}{4}$ in the high jump. Elliott was the victor on the basis of fewer misses.

John Pennel, world record holder at 17-10 $\frac{1}{4}$, won the pole vault at 17-5 $\frac{1}{4}$ and took three cracks at 18-0.

Diminutive Gerry Lindgren, former Washington State star running unattached, won the 5,000 meters in 13:58.3.

Texas A&M, which had a pending world record of 1:21.7 for the event, took the 880-yard relay in 1:23.2.

Jim Crawford, competing unattached, dipped under four minutes in winning the mile in 3:59.6.

Lee Evans, San Jose State's newly named assistant track coach, whipped a potent intermediate hurdle field in a torrid finish with Ralph Mann of Brigham Young University and Ron Whitney of the Southern California Striders.

Evans and Mann, who banged into each other as they went over the final hurdle, were both timed in 51.2,
