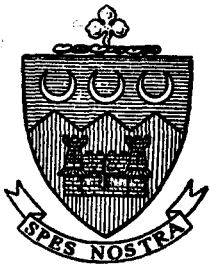

Dear Dick,

Enclosed are the the results of our 2nd annual Mt. St. Mary's Inviatational Decathlon meet. We had six men over 6000 points and a real fine effort from Jeff Bannister, U. of New Hampshire, who scored 7550, just 100 short of his lifetime best.

The dual between Bannister and Mount grad Bill Walsh, 1968 AAU All-Around champ, did not materialize since Walsh has not competed since August '68. His lowest point score ever, 6115.

It rained during 100 meters on the first day, but cleared later and we had good weather the rest of the way. We have 6 lane grasstex track.

7 of nine competitors claimed career bests. I think all decathlon competition should be limited to nine men (joke!). That's a managable field.
