

RULES CHANGES: The Pacific-8 Administrative Committee has approved the following changes for 1970:

1. Flights in the Field Events will complete all three trials before the next flight competes.
2. The Javelin must stick to be counted. Throws that stick, but fall or spin later will be counted at point of impact.

COACHES SCRATCH MEETING: Will be held on Thursday, May 14, at 7:30 p.m. in the Athletic Department Film Room. The Athletic Department Building is located adjacent to the northeast corner of Pauley Pavilion.

PARTICIPANTS DINNER: All coaches, competitors and athletic officials are cordially invited to an informal complimentary dinner on Friday evening following the last event. Athletes are welcome to attend in their sweats.

PACIFIC-8 TRACK COACHES MEETING: Time and place will be decided at the scratch meeting Thursday evening, May 14.

UCLA TRACK FACILITIES: The Running Track is Tartan surfaced. Spikes must not exceed  $3/8$ " in length. The Javelin Runway is dirt. We recommend 1" spikes, but the Javelin men must avoid all Tartan surfaces while wearing the longer spikes. The High Jump Runway is Tartan. We recommend  $3/8$ " spikes. The Long Jump and Triple Jump Runway is Tartan. Spike length must not exceed  $3/8$ ". All starting blocks will be furnished by UCLA.

DRESSING ROOMS: We regret that we will be unable to furnish locker facilities and towel service May 15 and 16. It is suggested that teams use their motel rooms for dressing rooms.

TRAINING AND MEDICAL CARE: The Training Room in Pauley Pavilion will be open to participants on May 15 and 16. Rub down tables will be available in the warm-up area next to the track.

WEIGHTING OF IMPLEMENTS: All implements to be used in the meet must be checked between 1:30 and 2:30 on Friday, May 15, at the north end of the Track Stadium grandstand.

PUBLICITY INFORMATION: Please send your 1970 Track Press Book, photos and other information to: Vic Kelley, UCLA Athletic News Bureau, Los Angeles, California 90024. All requests for press, radio and television credentials must be referred to Mr. Kelley.

TICKETS: May be purchased by writing to the UCLA Athletic Ticket Office, P.O. Box 24607, Los Angeles, California 90024. General Admission is \$2.00 for Friday, \$3.00 for Saturday. Students \$1.00 both days.
