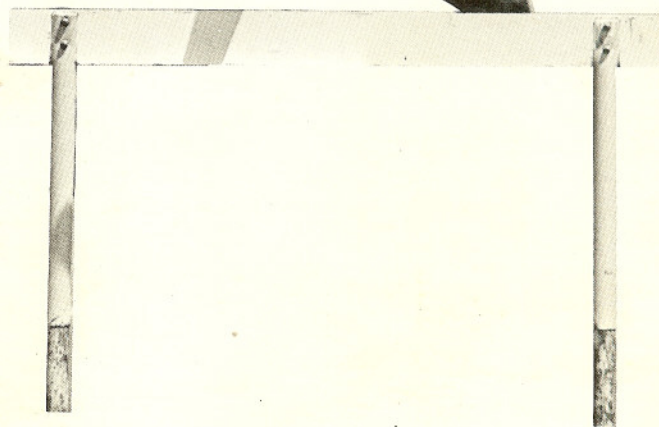
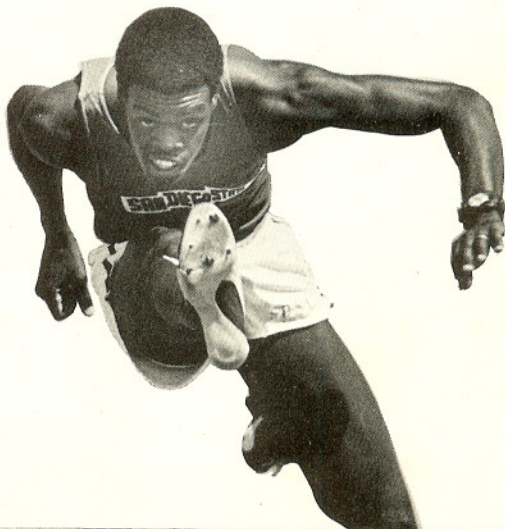

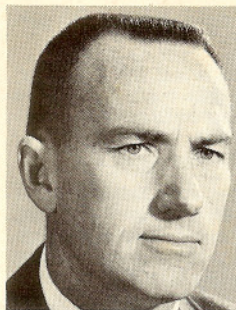

DICK WELLS

Head Track and Field Coach



Guiding the Aztecs into the 1970's will be Dick Wells who will be beginning his fourth season as head coach. Wells took over the reins as head coach from long-time veteran Choc Sportsman in 1967 after having served as Sportsman's assistant since 1961.

Wells began his coaching career at Occidental College, where he received his B.A. degree in 1953, as an assistant to Peyton Jordan. After one year at Oxy, Wells came to San Diego State and, apart from helping out Sportsman, was also the

Aztec freshman-JV football coach.

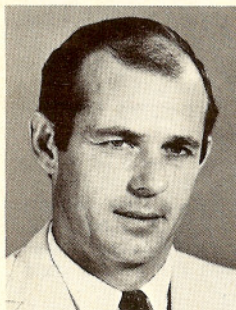
Surprisingly, Wells concentrated on football when he was a student at Occidental, playing four seasons and being named to the all-conference team once. He also competed in track for one season and threw the discus, but, as Dick puts it, "I was not very good." Wells was also a footballer in high school, starring for North Hollywood High School where he was all-league and all-city.

A Navy veteran from 1953-60, Dick is married to the former Barbara Kyne and has three children: Rick 14, Ken, 13, and Laura, 10.

Academically, besides his B.A., Wells holds a M.A. from San Diego State and is currently working on his Ph.D. through the United States International University.

TONY SUCEC

Assistant Track and Field Coach



Assisting head coach Dick Wells this season will be Tony Sucec who also doubles as the Aztec cross country coach. This actually is Tony's second tour of duty as an assistant track and field coach on the Mesa as he also worked under Choc Sportsman, along with Wells, from 1963-65. Tony has been in his present position since the 1967 season. Prior to returning to SDS he was the assistant fresh cross country and track and field coach at UC Berkeley from 1965-67.

Although born in Oakland, Sucec has spent most of his days here in the San Diego area. He attended St. Augustine High School, San Diego City College and finished up a State where he received both his A.B. and M.A. degrees. Tony also holds a Ph.D. degree from UC Berkeley.

A fine athlete himself, Sucec was the California Collegiate Athletic Association cross country champion in 1958 and then was runner-up in the CCAA mile during the 1959 track season. Additionally, he was a member of the All-Army team in 1960.

Tony is married (Marian) and has two children.

THE SEASON TO COME

If the outstanding performances of past San Diego track and field teams are any indication, then the statement by head coach Dick Wells that the 1970 team could be the best team ever should mean something.

Wells has good reason to be optimistic about the 1970 campaign. No less than 17 Aztecs whose marks place them in the top 10 of all-time SDS performances are returning. And considering the fact that several of them are ranked in two or more events makes this total even more impressive.

"I wouldn't say we have no weaknesses," remarks coach Wells. "I'd have to say we're somewhat weak in the sprints, but there is a lot of new material so this may develop into one of our better events. We do, however, have some problems in the javelin and the shot which may stay with us all season.

"What I like about this team is its overall balance and depth. We're going to be strong in the distance events, long jump, pole vault and hurdles which means we can pick up a lot of valuable points to offset any losses," sums up Wells.

Only two men are returning in the dash events, Dan Patton (21.6) and Wes Williams (48.0). However, the Aztecs will have some good junior college transfers in Eddie Steward (Santa Ana 9.8 and 21.6), Lynn Meyer (Santa Ana 9.8 and 21.6), Ralph Lavage (Grossmont 9.8 and 21.4) and Tom Hayes from the football team by way of the U.S. Army and Riverside City College.

Joining Williams in the quarter-mile will be senior Dick Watson at 48.0 and transfer James King (Mesa).

The picture is quite rosy for the Aztecs in the distance events as they are loaded with talent. Foremost of the distance men is junior Tim Danielson who was the second high school athlete to break the four-minute mile when he ran a 3:59.2 for Chula Vista High School in 1966. Danielson is the school record holder in the mile at 4:05.1 and holds the Pacific Coast Athletic Association mark at 4:11.7. Tim also has 1:53.0, 9:06.4 and 14:06.4 clockings to his credit. Joining Tim will be school and PCAA six-mile record holder Roger Friend (30:01.8) and PCAA three-mile record holder Charlie Winsor (14:18.0). Friend also has 9:10.8 and 14:25.6 timings while Winsor has turned in 4:13.7 and 14:18.0 times.

Along with this veteran trio will be returnees John Roberts (1:53.8), Bob Messina (4:10.1), Pete Virgadamo (4:10.5), Dave Hamblen (9:08.0 and a school record 14:03.4), John Jacobsen (9:08.8 and 14:22.0) and Tom Davidson (9:50.2 in the 3,000-meter steeplechase). Top newcomer from the JC ranks is Clark Dimond with a 1:52.8 from Mesa who won the state JC championship in the 880.

The Aztecs are also blessed with a fine group of hurdlers headed by Williams who holds the PCAA 440 IH record at 52.8 plus a 14.8 in the lows. A couple of transfer students figure in Wells' hurdle plans in James King (Mesa) 14.7 and 52.0 and decathlon prospect Don Bajema (Mesa) 54.0. State will also have Rick Olander by way of Grossmont and UCLA at 14.9.

In the field events newcomer Arnie Robinson (Mesa) looks like a real good catch. Robinson has a 25-6 in the long jump (which would be second best on the all-time Aztec list) and a 48-4 in the triple best (which would be a new SDS record). Returning in the two events are Byron Gutwein, (24-11¼), Dan Reeves (24-4 and 46-1) and Williams with a school record of 47-7½.

Billie Hayes is the lone returning bright spot in the high jump at 6-6 and has the potential to hit 6-9 or better. He'll be joined by Don Sing (Mesa) at 6-6 and senior Byron Upham who's done 6-8 in inramural action.

Looking to higher heights in the pole vault, the Aztecs have come up with a pair of transfers each of whom has a mark almost 10 inches better than the existing school record. The

talented duo is Rick Olander and Steve Aubry (Pierce College and the University of Arizona) who have both gone 16-0 and sat out last year. Back to try to improve on a mark of 14-0 is senior Joe Miyoshi.

State will be weak in the shot, but will have the services of some veteran discus men in Mike Johnson (160-11), Dennis McClanahan (149-10½) and Rick Ziegler, freshman record holder at 148-8.

Top men in the javelin event appear to be transfers Bob Crogan (San Diego City College) at 208 and decathlon man Bajema at 194.
