Van Hofweger Paces Striders

Former Bruin Len Van Hofweger led the Striders to a triangular track and field victory at UCLA Saturday, winning the 440 in 46.1 and running a 46.8 anchor leg in the mile relay.

The Striders scored 103 points, followed by UCLA with 42 and the Pacific Coast Club with 24.

Van Hofweger barely edged UCLA's John Smith in the 440, the Bruin runner recording his all-time best of 46.2. UCLA's Wayne Collett scratched from the race because of a virus.

John Pennel of the Striders, world record holder in the pole vault, made an impressive 1970 debut, winning his event at 17-0.
