

Collett Beats Williams as Bruins Trim Aztecs

Wayne Collett set stadium record of 51.2 in the 440-yard intermediate hurdles to win his duel with San Diego State's Wes Williams in UCLA's opening dual meet Satur-day at Westwood.

The Bruins won the meet, 112-41.

Williams, second in last ar's NCAA championyear's year's NCAA cnampion-ships in 49.7, was off first in the race but Collett collared him on the last turn and pulled away to win before a crowd of 3,200. Williams was clocked in 51.8.

UCLA's Hartzell Alpizar ran a lifetime best of 8:54.2 to outfinish San Diego State's Chuck Winsor in a thrilling two-mile duel. Winsor also was clocked in 2:512 in 8:54.2.

Steve Gibson, UCLA freshman from Lakewood High, upset junior team-mate Reggie Robinson in the 220 with a 21.3 clocking.

UCLA pole vaulter Jon Vaughn missed the meet with injuries.
