SUBJECT: FOUR RECORDS BROKEN IN BADGER INTRA-SQUAD MEET

MADISON, WIS -- UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN'S ANNUAL INDOOR INTRA-SQUAD TRACK AND FIELD MEET PRODUCED FOUR GREAT PERFORMANCES HERE THURSDAY NIGHT.

JUNIOR MARK WINZENRIED, MONROE RAN THE FASTEST MILE EVER TURNED IN BY A BIG TEN UNDERGRADUATE PERFORMER AS HE OUTSPRINTED FELLOW JUNIOR DON VANDREY IN THE FINAL 220 YARDS TO WIN IN 4:01.9. AN HOUR LATER WINZENRIED CAME BACK TO DEFEAT VANDREY AGAIN -- THIS TIME IN THE HALF-MILE -- IN THE FINE TIME OF 1:50.7. VANDREY WAS TIMED IN 4:03.3 FOR THE MILE AND 1:51.9 FOR THE HALF-MILE.

SOPHOMORE PAT MATZDORF, SHEBOYGAN (NORTH) BECAME THE FOURTH BIG TEN ATHLETE TO CLEAR SEVEN FEET IN THE HIGH JUMP AS HE LEAPED 7 FEET $\frac{1}{4}$ INCH ON HIS FIRST ATTEMPT AT THE HEIGHT; HE LATER MISSED THREE ATTEMPTS AT 7 FEET 1 INCH. TEAMMATE JIM HUFF, MADISON (WEST) SOPHOMORE CLEARED 6 FEET 10 INCHES.

SOPHOMORE GREG 'GRAPE JUICE' JOHNSON WAS A TRIPLE WINNER AS HE SET AN ALL-TIME WISCONSIN SCHOOL RECORD OF 24 FEET 11 INCHES IN THE LONG JUMP AND CAME UP WITH VICTORIES IN THE 70 YARD HIGH AND LOW HURDLES RACES. JOHNSON WON THE HIGHS IN 8.7 SECS., AND THE LOWS IN 8.0 SECS.

FRESHMAN GLENN HEROLD, WATERTOWN, TURNED IN THE FASTEST TWO MILE RUN EVER BY A BADGER WITH A TIME OF 8:58.6 IN DEFEATING SOPHOMORE BOB SCHARNKE, BARABOO WHO HAD HIS BEST TIME EVER OF 9:05.2. JUNIOR DEAN MARTELL, SOMERSET, WIS., LAST YEAR'S BIG TEN OUTDOOR THREE MILE CHAMPION, WAS THIRD IN 9:08.8.

WINZENRIED'S QUARTER TIMES FOR HIS GREAT RUN WERE 60, 61, 62, AND 58.9 SECONDS, RESPECTIVELY WHILE VANDREY, WHO LED THE FIRST THREE QUARTERS OF THE RACE WAS CAUGHT IN SPLITS OF 59, 61.2, 60.8 AND 63.3 SECONDS, RESPECTIVELY.
