

# Record Set At Carlmont

Los Altos' Chris Adams set a state record, six meet marks fell and Berkeley High won its third Carlmont High Track and Field Invitational Saturday afternoon in Belmont.

Berkeley outdistanced a set of perennial Northern California prep track powers, with El Cerrito, Los Altos, Pittsburg, Cupertino and host Carlmont following in that order.

Adams heaved the discus 196-2½, breaking the state standard of 195-4 shared by Los Altos' Bob Stoecker (1962) and Gunn's Tom Birtwhistle (1969). Although he has an effort of over 198 to his credit this year, it came in a dual meet, with state marks recognized only in competition involving five or more schools.

Later, the Los Altos strong boy bounced back to set a meet and field record of 61-9¼ in the shot put to lead his school to wins in both weight events.

All events, running the field, were scored on the cumulative results of four-man teams.

The Los Altos Knights set another impressive meet record when they won the mile relay in 3:18.2 — the best prep time in California this season. The Knights' team averaged an amazing 49.6 for the 440, including Rick Brown's 48.1.

Brown also clocked a 1:53.0 in his 880 leg of the two-mile relay.

Carlmont distance runners Hans Templeman and Steve Miller finished first individually in the mile and two mile, respectively.

Templeman won the one mile with a good time of 4:24.5 — which would have been an SPAL seasonal best except it was run as a relay leg. Miller, only a freshman, won the two-mile in 9:48.2. He has a seasonal best 9:39.9.

Gunn High won its own really carnival Saturday, scoring 87 points to runnerup Crestmoor's 70 in a meet in which 10 meet records fell.

# Adams sets state mark

Chris Adams of Los Altos High set a state high school discus record with a throw of 196 feet 2½ inches during Saturday's six-team Carlmont Relays track and field meet held at Belmont.

Berkeley won the meet with

71 points, followed by El Cerrito with 50, Los Altos 49, Pittsburg 35, Cupertino 33 and Carlmont 28.

Although Adams has a better throw of 198 feet this season, his effort Saturday was officially declared a record since at

least six teams must compete in a meet for a mark to qualify.

Los Altos also turned in the fastest mile relay time in the state this year, being clocked in 3:18.2.
