

# Local Trackmen Nab Trophies

San Carlos and Carlmont high school track teams went in different directions Saturday, but both came back with some trophies.

San Carlos competed in the Pacific Grove Invitational in the Monterey Bay area and returned with a second place in the varsity competition and first in the frosh-soph division.

Carlmont, meanwhile, sent just a Class B team to the El Cerrito Relays in the East Bay and came home with a second place effort.

At Pacific Grove, San Carlos trailed champion Monterey 38-42 in the 13-team large school varsity division, and won the frosh-soph division with 61 points to 42 for runnerup Salinas.

Among the top Don varsity efforts was a 9:44.0 clocking for first place in the two mile by Randy Lawson and a 2:00.8 for second in the 880 by Matt Phillippe.

Gene Davis set a SC school record with a 14.9 effort in the trials of the 120 high hurdles. He was fourth in the finals at 15.3 and also took second in the low hurdles and third in the discus. Dave Pina aided the Don cause with a fourth in the 100, second in the long jump and fourth in the triple jump.

San Carlos received firsts in the frosh-soph division from its 440 relay team (46.0), Mike

Grossman in the 220 (23.5), Herman Jackson in the triple jump (41-11) and Mark Wilmarth in the high jump (6-0).

Carlmont's frosh-soph team won the distance medley relay at El Cerrito with a 10:31.8 clocking, which broke the Scots' own meet record by 16 seconds. Highlighting the winning squad were Hans Templeman with a 4:23 split in the mile and freshman Steve Miller with a fine 3:10.5 split for his 1320 leg. Scott Carvey and Ken Dodge completed the team.

The Scots scored 24 points to tie for second with Concord, Kennedy and Richmond behind Class B champion El Cerrito's 48 points. Host El Cerrito also won the Class A division.
