atlantic coast conference indoor meet

Chapel Hill, N.C., Feb. 27/ by Gene Cherry/ ---Red-haired Maryland senior Jack Hanley complained of a cold, but still had enough steam to put the shot an Atlantic Coast Conference indoor record $60-1\frac{1}{2}$ in the 18th annual conference indoor games here.

The effort, his second toss of the afternoon, broke by two feet, five inches Hanley's old record of $57-8\frac{1}{2}$, set in 1969.

"I should have had a better series ($59-5\frac{1}{2}$, $60-1\frac{1}{2}$, $57-3\frac{1}{4}$, $57-9\frac{1}{2}$, scratch, $57-9$), but after the first couple of throws I didn't feel like doing anything," Hanley said afterwards.

"I've had the flu twice and now I've got a cold."

North Carolina's John Jessup was second with a PR $58-5\frac{1}{4}$.

Duke freshman Bob Wheeler, already the ACC cross country champion this school year, used a 57-second final quarter to add the mile crown to his list of honors. Wheeler was timed in a conference record 4:05.9.

Two-time champion and record-holder (4:07.3) John Baker of Maryland was unable to defend his title because of an injury.

Another first-year man, Tony Waldrop of North Carolina erased the conference standard of 2:12.8 in the 1000 with a 2:09.7 performance. He was pushed by Maryland's Marty Brotemarkle (2:10.3) and South Carolina's Jim Schrapper (2:10.6).

North Carolina two-miler Larry Widgeon established a new mark in his speciality, running an 8:53.4. Maryland's Russ Taintor, who was unable to defend his two-time title because of an injury, held the former record of 9:00.5.

Maryland high jumper Joe David became a three-time champ by clearing 6-10 for the third time. He won in previous years at 6-10 $\frac{1}{4}$ and 6-10 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Maryland, with 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ points, swept the team title for the 17th year, 16 in succession. Duke had 34, North Carolina 32, South Carolina 30, Clemson 17 $\frac{1}{2}$, North Carolina State and Virginia 12 and Wake Forest 5.
