The Vancouver Olympic Club will be hosting the Twenty-third Annual Vancouver Relays (Open Division) at Stanley Park, Vancouver, B.C., commencing at 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 1st. 1971.

The 31 Events (8 Relays and 23 Individual Events) will be divided into TWO Divisions:-

OPEN MEN'S - Any registered amateur athlete who meets the MINIMUM standard.

OPEN WOMEN'S - Any registered amateur athlete who meets the MINIMUM standard.

ENTRY FEES - \$1.00 per athlete.

#### IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

#### A. AMATEUR CARDS FOR ENTRANTS

- 1. All contestants must be registered and in entering or being entered, subject themselves to the rules of the organization.
- 2. <u>U.S.ATHLETES</u> Application to be made to the nearest Association for Amateur Cards and International Permits.
- 3. <u>CANADIAN ATHLETES</u> Entries will NOT be accepted unless current Amateur Number is listed on entry form.
- 4. Athletes who enter, or who are entered, and fail to appear may be brought before their Card Issuing Authority to explain their reasons for non-appearance.

#### B. ENTRIES

- 1. The right to reject any Entry is reserved.
- 2. All Entries must be made on the OFFICIAL ENTRY FORM (or photocopy).
- 3. Entries will <u>NOT</u> be accepted unless the athlete has equalled or bettered the standard for the Event WITHIN THE PRECEDING 12 MONTHS.
- 4. All entries must be accompanied by the ENTRY FEES.
- 5. ENTRIES MUST BE POST-MARKED NOT LATER THAN APRIL 20th.
- 6. POSITIVELY NO TELEPHONE, LATE OR POST ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
