fr State eshman Diego San Diego State freshman Jerry Culp shattered a 21-year-old Aztec high jump record when he leaped 7 feet, 1 inch, the nation's best outdoor jump this year, in an all-comers meet at the Aztec track yesterday af-ternant

this year, at the Aztec track year ternoon. The rangy athlete out of Oceanside High, whose 7¼ leap last year was the nation's best high school mark, beat the for-mer Aztec record of 6-8¼ set by Jack Razzeto in the 1950 Texas Relays. Culp, who wastes little time culp, who wastes little time

Culp, who wastes little time between jumps, unlike most high jumpers and pole vaulters, first set the Aztec record with a leap of 6-9. He later cleared seven feet by at least two inches on his second jump and then topped 7-1 on his third and final chance final chance.

Tom Heinonen of San Diego Track Club set a track record of 29 minutes, 4.6 seconds for six miles, and Aztec Mike Cour posted an Aztec meet and track record of 9:21.9 for the 2 000 meter steplechase

posted an Aztec Inter track record of 9:21.9 for the 3,000-meter steeplechase. Aztec Eddie Steward was clocked in 9.8 seconds for the 100-yard dash, Aztec Chip Min-nick did a 1:57.3 for the half mile, and State's Jim King won both the 120 and 440 hurdles.
