Aztecs Win On Disqualification

San Diego State edged Long Beach State, 80-74, in their Pacific Coast AA track and field meet at Choc Sportsman track here yesterday when the Long Beach mile relay team was disqualified after winning that four-lap event.

As predicted, the meet went down to the mile relay and the visiting 49ers triumphed in 3:14.8 when anchorman Danny Moore hit the string five yards ahead of Aztec Eddie Steward.

On the third lap, however, 49er Clarence Palmer, after taking the baton in the pole lane, moved into the second lane, forcing Aztec Tim Vicent into the third lane and three officials later disqualified the 49ers for the infraction.

Palmer also waved his baton at Vincent, and was talking to him, as they headed for the first turn nearly shoulder to shoulder.

If the 49er mile-relay victory would have stood up they would have won the meet, 79-75, because relay winners get five points and the losers, none.

The meet featured a great head-and-head match between Aztec Arnie Robinson, the National Collegiate long jump champion, and 49er Doyle Steel, former San Diego High and San Diego City College star.

Robinson led his Long Beach rival in both events until Steel's last leaps. But Steel won the long jump by an inch, 25 feet, 2¾ inches to 25-1¾, and the triple jump by 1½ inches, 49-9½ to 49-8.

Robinson gained a measure of revenge by taking second in the high jump, where Aztec ace Jerry Culp hiked his school record from 7 feet to 7-1½. Culp

barely missed on his second and third shots at 7-3.

In the high jump, Robinson jumped 6-10, four inches over his previous best, while Steel could clear only 6-8.

The Aztecs got off to an unlucky start when Mike Cour, leading the 3,000-meter steeplechase by 15 yards with three laps left, hit a barrier with his trailing leg, fell to the track and didn't finish.

It still looked bad for the Aztecs late in the meet, despite a strong double by Tim Danielson in the mile and half-mile. Then Culp and Robinson went 1-2 at the high jump pit, footballer Henry Allison and Mike Crawford were 1-2 in the discus and then came the mile-relay disqualification.
