Now all I have to do is get my timing straightened out. Usually I don't get too much distance on the hop-step portion of the jump. Today my timing was off and I was moving better in the first part and then coming up short on the jump at the end."

Even more impressive was the performance of defending NCAA 100 champion Eddie Hart on a windy, wet course. Hart won the 100 in 9.5, the 220 in 21.1 and anchored the 440 relay team to an easy victory in 40.8.

A year ago Hart lost to Kirk Clayton in the 100 and teammate Isaac Curtis in the longer race. In fact, he had never defeated Curtis in dual meet competition.

So, what's the difference?

"Last year my start was inconsistent," Hart said. "Sometimes it would be pretty good, other times just horrible. The combination of the work I've done on starting, and greater experience have made a better runner."

"I'm not a cocky kind of guy. But I really think I can run with anybody when I'm on. It doesn't hurt running with Isaac. Anytime he's in the race I can't afford to do anything but my best."

"Take the 220 this afternoon, for example. I took the lead coming around the turn and wanted to ease up a little at the finish. But I could hear Isaac coming up behind me and I knew I had to go to work."

For the second straight week John Drew improved his lifetime best in the mile. He let Buck Black of San Jose and teammate Cliff

West set the pace for two laps and then, when West faltered, he came charging up to pass Black on the last turn.

Drew's time was 4:10.2, 3.3 seconds faster than last week's winning effort.

"We were surprised by Drew," Bullard said, "We felt strongly that Black could beat West and we geared the race that way. About midway through I saw our mistake; that we were setting up Drew for his finishing kick."
