Both seem delighted with early season ~~progress~~ progress and felt they could have gone much faster. Burkwist was no problem — he dropped off as soon as Gerry "threw in" ~~and~~ one of his 50-100-yard bursts in first mile.

Olsen is in splendid shape. They'll take X-rays this week and he may get to lose cast, and/or finally put ~~on~~ some pressure on wrist. Wharton hadn't been expected to run because of heel bruise, but felt good late in week — and did a good job of it.

Jack Ernst may finally be ready for break-through. Finally got above 16, cleared 16-4 with many inches to spare, ~~has~~ has been very consistent and on present indications should be at 16-8, maybe 17, by late season. But, as Hill knows, predicting ~~anything~~ anything with Ernst is risky.

Finally, the most important news for last: Tom Robinson got a ~~hair~~ haircut and ran for WSU JVs at Spokane Falls. (Gabby is being careful — NCAA may add a marathon any second now).
