TRACK OPENER

White Leads Tribe Blitz

STANFORD — Randy White set a new Stanford record in the 440-yard intermediate hurdles Saturday as the Indians launched their 1971 track and field season with a pair of easy victories over Occidental and Fresno State at Stanford Stadium.

The Indians trounced Oxy 109-35 and Fresno 120-25.

White, a senior from Burlingame, raced over the barriers in 51.3 seconds to clip two-tenths of a second off the mark he set as a sophomore in 1969.

Several other members of coach Payton Jordan's Indian squad came up with life-time bests in an impressive opening effort.

Tom Anderson, slender sophomore from Los Altos, turned in career bests in both the long jump and high jump to become one of Stanford's three double winners. He captured the long jump with a 25-1 effort on his last jump and was a surprise winner in the high jump at 6-6.

Chuck Francis won the 100 in 9.7 and the 220 in 21.6 and anchored Stanford's winning 440 relay team. Steve Davis won the shot at 53-6½ and the discus at 163-9.

Stanford won all but four events, plus the non-scoring steeplechase. The Indians swept the 120 high hurdles as Rick Tipton returned to the form which made him Pacific-8 champion two years ago. Tipton won in 13.8, but had to clear only nine hurdles as someone forgot to set up the final set of barriers. Stanford also swept the 880 as Duncan Macdonald won in 1:53.8, and ran 1-2 in four other events.

"I was very pleased with the showing," stated Jordan. "It is the best opener I can remember, time-wise and distance-wise. From top to bottom we did very well. Randy White set one school record and we were close in others. Several of our athletes turned in marks which were better than they did all last year."

Jordan was especially pleased with the showing of freshman Bill Raines of Los Alamitos who had a lifetime best of 22-11 in the long jump, and Tom Long, sophomore from Sacramento, who had career bests in both hurdle events.

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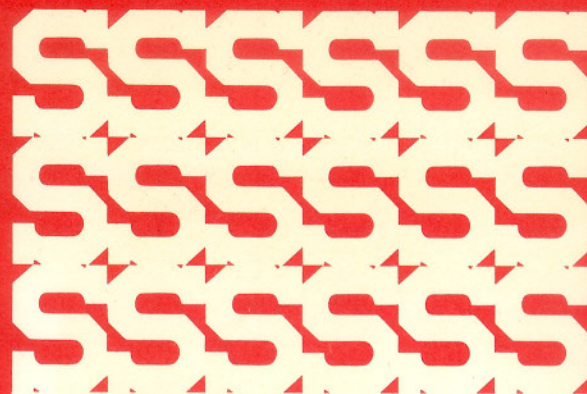
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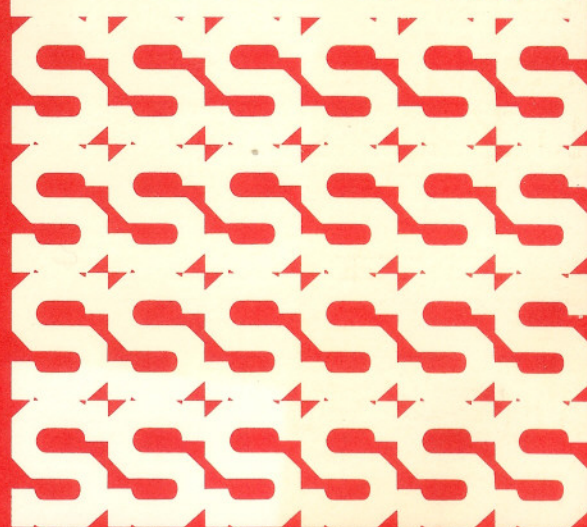
