Mark Murro, America's foremost javelin thrower and ranked No. 3 in the world, leads the Arizona State track team against UCLA in an early-season intersectional dual meet in the Bruin Track Stadium tomorrow starting at 1:15 p.m.

Murro holds every U.S.A. javelin record in the books, including the pending American and National Collegiate record of 300 feet even set last year, the junior college mark of 273-0 set in 1968 and the prep standard of 252-8 set in 1967. Last year, he set the Bruin Stadium record of 279-2 and indicated he likes to throw in the Westwood facility.

Although they don't have anyone to challenge the superb Mr. Murro, the Bruins' javelin corps, headed by 1970 State JC champion Peter Jones from San Diego Mesa College, figure to be inspired by competing against one of the world's greats. Jones impressed last week with a 221-10 toss. His career best is 232-6.

Besides Murro, Arizona State has several other talented performers ready to go against coach Jim Bush's powerful Bruins, who figure to win their 10th straight dual meet over a two-season span. In the long jump, the Sun Devils have a 25-footer, Steve Holden, who might push the sensational James McAlister, who has leaped 25-3 3/4 and 25-9 1/4 in his first two meets as a Bruin.

The visitors from Tempe, Ariz., also have two distance stars, miler Mark Rafferty (4:09.9) and two-miler Bob Bogleione (8:51.6) who will test UCLA's young but promising runners. The Bruins are counting on such former prep greats as Ruben Chappins (8:57.0), Ron Johnson (4:13.9 and 8:55.6) and Rick Tschudin (4:13.1) to come fast in their specialties.

Meanwhile coach Eush announces that UCLA's ace sprinter, Warren Edmonson, is probably lost for the entire month of March because of a pulled leg muscle suffered last week. Ronnie Welch and Reggie Echols will carry on in the dashes for both Edmonson and veteran Reggie Robinson, who is currently ineligible.

A nominal admission charge of \$2 for adults and \$1 for youngsters will be made for tomorrow's meet. However, UCLA season track tickets, priced at the special amount of \$11, will be on sale at the Stadium box office.
