Dear Dick,

Enclosed are results of today's UCLA - Long Beach State dual meet. As you probably are aware, the Long Beach Relays were not run today and to the best of my knowledge are not scheduled for later in the season.

With a few exceptions, marks were of a pretty good caliber, especially in the horizontal jumps. Rogers and Walker were consistently hitting 50' plus in the triple, and McAlister again got his big jump on the first try.

Edmonson would have had at least 9.5, probably 9.4 if he hadn't suffered a muscle pull 10 yds from the tape. Smith's win in the 440 wasn't really as harrowing as the times would indicate. He had the outside lane with Jones on the far inside. Smith led through the first 220 then "coasted" the curve and Jones passed him and had about a five yard lead going into the straight. When Smith saw Jones with the lead, he turned it on again, caught him 20 yards from the tape and won going away. The 440 relay was a thriller and both teams could be heard from before the year is out. The big difference was the middle two legs as Jones and London simply outgunned Smith and Echols. Edmonson was able to gain only a yard on Moore

down the final straight. Collett's 880 was a surprise - he ran both quarters in a bit over 56 and although he labored the last 30 yards, he beat sub 1:50 teammates Bob Langston and Paul Williams by a substantial margin. He's already got my vote for "athlete of the Year" - he certainly ranks among the most versatile and most competitive runners I've ever seen.

Corral looked 100% more impressive in the intermediates than he did last week. He not only avenged his defeat at the hands of Roger Johnson (and get a lifetime best, to boot) but appeared to hold his form much better throughout the race. Ostorich also improved substantially over last week with a good double. Fresh Roger Freberg could also be a comer in the division as he improved 14 feet to 173-5.
