

Titans Take Track Title At Buchser ³⁻²⁹

SANTA CLARA — Gunn High added to the prestige of the SPAL and also showed stronger title potential than ever with a team championship in the first Buchser High Track Relays here Saturday.

The Titans, paced by an excellent all-around effort by Dave Bagshaw, won both hurdles relays, the long and triple jumps and pole vault, discus and shot put relays to edge Pleasant Hill for the crown, 100 to 98.

Bagshaw had 14.5 and 19.3 splits in the high and low hurdles, respectively, leaped a school record-tying 6-5 in the high jump and ran a 50.5 split in the mile relay.

The Titans were disqualified on a post-relay technicality or would have had a 3:26.8 clocking to their credit.

Acorns Win Six-Team ³⁻²⁹ Track Meet

Menlo School came out on the winning side in both a dual score and six-way tally in a track meet for private schools at Menlo Saturday.

The Acorns, behind double winners Dennis Daniels of Woodside and Tim Griffith, knocked off Robert Louis Stevenson 83-63 and also beat the other four schools entered.

Menlo totaled 113 points while California School for the Deaf had 80, Stevenson 63, York 54, San Rafael Military Academy 22 and Lick-Wilmerding 13 as the Acorns won most events.
