In frosh-soph competition, Sequoia's Dave Data, Randy Krigbaum and Jose Gonzales won the shot put relay and were second in the discus, while San Carlos' Ron Cartmell, Lee Shoop, John Schuyler and Bruce Veal teamed to take the two-mile relay.
