

Four Locals Place First In MBL Track Meet Finals

SALINAS — Bob Burns and Gary Ryan of Harbor, Eloy Villa of Santa Cruz and Dan Gruber of Aptos High all won first places in the Monterey Bay League track meet Saturday at Hartnell College in Salinas.

Burns hurled the discus 158-7 for his first place league finish. In addition, he placed fourth in the shot put at 48-2 3/4. Top four finishers in each event qualified to compete in Saturday's Central Coast Section Region IV meet in Pacific Grove.

Ryan cleared the bar at 12-6 to win first place in the pole vault. Teammate Mike Nohrden went 11-6 for a third-place finish.

Villa set a new Santa Cruz High record in the 800 as he raced to first place in the event with a 1:57.5 clocking. The old mark, 1:57.7, also belonged to Villa.

Gruber highlighted the mile run, in which all four top places were earned by county runners. Gruber topped the field in 4:25.2. Teammate Darrell Fitzgerald was second, Tony Munros of Watsonville was third and Steve Graap of Soquel was fourth.

Ace distance runner Joel Jameson of Watsonville easily won his two-mile event in 9:44.3. Don Schwartz of Soquel was second at 9:50.2.

Santa Cruz High's Ernie Hightower qualified in a pair of events as he placed third in the 440 at 51.3 and fourth in the 220 with a time of 23.0. Teammate Ron Staub also picked up a fourth place when he hurled the discus 136-10.

The two Monterey Peninsula league schools dominated varsity competition. Seaside won the team honor with 68 points and

Monterey was second with 40. Watsonville finished in third place with 33 points, Salinas fourth with 26 and Harbor fifth with 23. North High placed sixth with 18 points, Alisal and Santa Cruz tied for seventh with 14. Aptos placed ninth with 10 and Soquel last with seven points.

Jim Anderson, Mike Morgan and Gary McConnell topped north county participants in the league fresh-soph meet. Anderson won the high jump (5-8) and Morgan the triple jump (44-2 3/4) for a pair of first places for Aptos. In addition, Morgan placed second in the 40.

McConnell beat out Soquel teammate Alex Miguez for first place in the 2-mile. Their times were 10:18.5 and 10:23.2, respectively.

Third place finishes were scored by Aptos' Fred Gleasing

in the 220, Soquel's Mark Wagner in the mile and Santa Cruz' Rich Vanslager in the pole vault.

Placing fourth were Greg Feaster in the 100 and 220 and Steve Box in the pole vault. Both are from Soquel High.
