

'Cat Spikes Win Title

When Crestmoor High long jumper Fred Geipel pulled a muscle badly in the middle of that event in the MPL Track Finals yesterday, host San Mateo trackmen shed few tears.

Geipel, a favorite in the triple jump later, was unable to compete. San Mateo's Dennis Haysbert won it, setting the only finals record of the day at 44-1.

San Mateo went on to win the meet, amassing 79 points to Crestmoor's 64. The two teams had tied in the dual meet season at 5-1.

Crestmoor had won the dual meet with the Bearcats. But with the finals win, San Mateo took the over-all championship.

Capuchino was third yesterday with 43 points; Aragon had 39, Burlingame and Mills each 25 and Hillsdale 9.

The top five finishers in each

event go on to the Central Coast Section Region I meet next week at Serramonte.

San Mateo opened yesterday's meet with the best 440 relay clocking of the season in the MPL, 43.7.

Crestmoor's ace hurdler Bart Pierce followed in the high hurdles with one of the day's closest wins. Pierce clocked 14.8 to a 14.9 for Burlingame's Brett Johnson.

Crestmoor got another win from Pierce in the lows, and Falcon teammate Mike Paul got the 800 (1:59.7).

San Mateo got firsts from Ed Holly in the high jump (6-0) and Ryan Paton in the pole vault (13-6). And the Bearcats also got good places in most events — and that's what eventually made the difference.

Several potential winners

were out. Hillsdale discus man Skip House was missing with an injury. San Mateo discus man Dale Curry was recuperating from an operation. San Mateo miler Bill Lindsell had the red measles.

Capuchino's John Pagnani was the only double winner aside from Pierce. Pagnani heaved the shot 53-9/16 and hurled the discus 157-6, his best effort of the year.

Some of the marks were below the athletes' season bests, but San Mateo's Don Dooley, the host coach, said, "These are good realistic marks . . . some of the earlier ones were wind-aided and there was no wind today. Conditions were ideal."

Conditions couldn't have been better for Mills' Bill Giavia, who took the frosh-soph meet by storm.

Giavia started on Wednesday by setting a new MPL f-s finals record in the high jump at 6-0 1/2. Yesterday he came back to the 70 high hurdles and set another, at 9.2.

Hillsdale, led by double-winner Bob McKenney, topped all the others with 76 points. Hillsdale had been undefeated during the dual meet season.

San Mateo finished second with 55; Capuchino had 52, Mills 42, Crestmoor 39, Aragon 25 and Burlingame 15.

McKenney took the long jump (20-2 1/4) and the triple jump (42-1) and finished second in the low hurdles, won by teammate, Luther Jackson (21.3).

Another double winner was Capuchino's Jay Ashley, who tied the meet mark in the 100 at 16.4 and won the 220 in 23.5.
