Banducci Put Leads Serra To Spike Win

Tom Banducci lofted the shot put 58-8 $\frac{1}{4}$, fourth best in the Central Coast Section this season, to pace Serra High to a 70-66 West Catholic Athletic League track victory over visiting Bellarmine yesterday.

Banducci was the meet's lone double winner, also taking the discus at 141-0 as the Padres lifted their league record to 3-2.
