

Florant joins all-time best

Three all-time West Bay track and field bests were established in 1973, Plato Yanicks' fourth annual All-Time West Bay honor roll reveals.

Yanicks' veteran coach at Menlo-Atherton High and noted track historian, chalked up a 9.4 in the 100 by Wilson's Mike Farmer, a 21.0 in the 220 by Silver Creek's Millard Hampton and a 13.6 high hurdles by Palo Alto's Carl Florant as all-time bests.

Yanicks' selections are based on the all-time bests by athletes from San Francisco to San Jose. The picks are made solely on the basis of geography rather than league or section.

Los Altos dominates the West Bay honor roll with 19 selections, followed by Wilson (San Francisco) and Gunn with eight each, Cupertino with seven and Menlo-Ather-

ton with five. Some 47 schools are represented by at least one selection.

The Santa Clara Valley Athletic League is by far the most powerful circuit in the West Bay. The SCVAL accounts for 47 selections, more than twice as many as the next closest loop.

Along with Florant, other locals who broke into the top six in each category include Gunn's Steve Crowley (fourth, 4:11.3 mile); Gunn's Gordon MacMitchell (second, 9:01.6 two-mile) and San Carlos' Mitch Kingery (sixth, 9:09.4 two-mile).

Crowley ran his 4:11.3 at a national meet a couple of weeks ago in Illinois. His 4:11.9 in the State Meet at Woodland previously ranked fourth.
