

Johnk sets mark in M-A decathlon ⁶⁻²

Menlo-Atherton High's Carl Johnk showed he is more than just a runner yesterday.

Johnk, only a junior, won the annual M-A decathlon, topping his fellow Bear trackmen with a school-record 5,737 points. The old M-A mark was set by another pretty good athlete, Jimmy Watts, the 1972 Tribune Athlete of the Year.

Johnk won the 100 in 10.3, the 440 in 54.7, the shot put in 39-5, the long jump in 19-8, the 220 in 23.3 and his specialty, the 120 high hurdles, in 15.3.

Randy Tibbals was second with 4,060 points, followed by sophomore class champ Barry O'Neill (4,039), Mark Gerkenmeyer (3,849) and Mike Harnish (3,573). Mike Shibata was the senior class champ, while George Smith topped the freshmen.

The meet served as a tune-up for the SPAL decathlon Monday and Tuesday at San Carlos.

Murphy breaks decathlon mark ⁶⁻⁶

Senior Marlon Murphy of Sequoia High smashed his own record for the SPAL decathlon yesterday at San Carlos, but it may not last more than a year.

Murphy's 4,891 points bettered his winning 4,611 last year, but Menlo-Atherton junior Carl Johnk also broke the record with 4,709.

Murphy took three events, including the 100 and 440 as expected, along with a good 41-9 shot put for a non-weightman. Johnk won the high hurdles, his specialty, in 15-0 and captured the discus.

Ravenswood's Charles Jones, a sophomore who looms as one of the league's top stars in the next two years, won the

frosh-soph competition with 3,541 points, followed by M-A soph Maurice Galvez with 3,203.

Galvez' 20-4 $\frac{3}{4}$ long jump was the top mark in their division of the three-year old decathlon.
