Willis wins 880, 440; ³⁻²² Acorns lose

Junior middle distance ace Beau Willis remained unbeaten for the season yesterday, but the same couldn't be said for his Menlo School track team. The Acorns wound up in the middle of a triangular at Menlo with 50 points to Moreau's 80 and Serramonte's 31.

Willis, last year's Central Coast Section frosh-soph champ, eased to victories in the 880 (2:01.4) and 440 (53.1), and helped win the mile relay. But the Acorns lost their first against six victories.

"Beau hasn't really been tested yet. It'll take that great kid from Stevenson (Bob Cleary, whose 1:55.2 was good for third in the CCS varsity last year) to test him (in mid-April)," Acorn coach Bob Jones said.

Serramonte's Ike Allmond, a State Meet veteran, hit 14.5 in the 120 high hurdles and 20.0 for the 180 lows, "just super considering he was running in hail on a slow track," Jones observed.
