

# Williams Outruns Beck in 8:55.2 2-Mile in CIF Champions' Meet

There was no record, but Lompoc's Terry Williams appeared to care less.

Making his move on the first turn of the final lap, Williams ran away from his long-time rival, Santa Monica's Curtis Beck, to win the two mile in the CIF Meet of Champions before 6,000 fans Friday night at Citrus College.

Beck, the CIF record holder and defending State champion, was right with Williams for the first seven laps as they paced the field, but could not keep up on the last 440.

Williams' time was 8:55.2 and Beck clocked 9:02.0, far off the 8:48.8 Beck ran in last year's CIF meet.

There was a record in the race, Eric Hulst, 15, a freshman at Laguna Beach finished fifth in 9:04.4, 10 seconds better than the national frosh mark held by Juan Garcia of Redwood High in Visalia.

Other outstanding performances were turned in by Crespi pole vaulter Tim Curran and Santa Ana sprinter Clancy Edwards.

## Curran Vaults 16-2

Curran won the vault at 16-2, the best mark in the nation this year and eighth on the all-time prep list. Curran tried to establish a CIF record with the bar at 16-6 but failed three times.

Edwards, who swept both sprints in the 4-A meet, did it again in 9.6 and 21.5. He was most impressive in the 220 as Centennial's Larry Rawles appeared to jump the gun and take the lead but Edwards effortlessly moved ahead and won by five yards.

Lompoc's Alvin Gilmore set the pace for most of the mile but North Torrance's Barrie Williams took command with about 200 yards to go and won by about eight yards in 4:09.8. Gilmore was second in 4:11.3 and Bellflower's Bob O'Brien third in 4:11.6.

## Robinson Repeats

Centennial's Robin Robinson, who provided a mild surprise when he won the 440 in last week's 4-A meet, proved it was no fluke when he powered down the stretch to take a convincing victory in 48.7. Robinson started his move with about 220 yards to go and ripped past Beverly Hills' Jeff Leeds and Muir's Allan Sheats with about 60 yards remaining.

Sheats misjudged the finish line and wound up sixth, but gained fifth place and a berth in the State meet when University's Bob Bradford, who finished third, was disqualified for running out of his lane.

Sheats was luckier than Byron Baptiste of Pasadena, who led all the way in the 180 low hurdles before just clipping the final hurdle, stumbling and winding up sixth.

In the frosh-soph portion of the meet, top performers were Edison's Tom Lloy and Estancia's Ken Conner. Lloy took the 660 in a blistering 1:21.1 while Conner won the high jump at 6-6. Both are sophomores.

San Marcos won the girls

portion of the program with 21 points to 19 for Costa Mesa. Ruth Kleinsasser of Azusa took individual honors by winning the 880 in 2:16.8 and the 440 in 57.3.
