

Owls win, Dons lose

The Foothill College track squad won its second straight Golden Gate Conference encounter Friday, topping Laney 96-46.

The Owls, now 2-1, were led by Doug Hill, Ed Villarreal and Bryan McDowell.

Hill was the Owls lone double-winner, collecting firsts in the 100 and 220 yard sprints.

Villarreal posted the top 440 time in the GGC this season with a 49.0 clocking.

McDowell, held out of earlier competition because of eligibility problems, tied the Foothill pole vault record with a leap of 14-6.

Two-mile Rich Hart ran a 9:20.3 to win his specialty.

De Anza dropped a 75-70 encounter to Diablo Valley in another GGC meet.
