# Foothill runs past De Anza

Foothill College moved up a notch in the Golden Gate Conference track and field standings at the expense of rival De Anza Wednesday at Los Altos Hills.

The Owls, who got a school record in a pole vault despite windy conditions, easily handled the visiting Dons, 88-57, to improve their GGC record to 4-1.

Freshman Mark Lizotte provided the highlight of the meet when he vaulted 15-2 to break his own school mark of 15-0 which he set in the Santa Barbara Relays.

Tim Bergstresser of De Anza added a new mark to the Dons' record book by heaving the javelin 178-9 to win the event and eclipse the old mark by nearly a foot.


Other than the two school records, times were relatively slow and marks rather short due to the gale-like conditions.

Cliff Corbett picked up points for Foothill by winning both the 100 (10.1) and 220 (23.3). Jay Pushkin of Foothill won his discus duel with De Anza's Ron Allen, avenging a setback to Allen in the Santa Barbara Relays.
