# Harbor's Coulter Leads Area's CCS Qualifiers

**SALINAS** — Ten varsity and 15 frosh-soph Santa Cruz County athletes qualified for the Central Coast Section track and field championships Friday, earning CCS berths in the Region IV meet at Hartnell College.

Leading the county's varsity athletes was Harbor High's Don Coulter, who won the 220 and 440-yard dashes.

Coulter set a new region record with his 49.0 clocking in the quarter and came back to win the 220 in 22.1.

Also nabbing first places were Soquel's Marty Capron and Watsonville's Mark Sambrillo.

Capron set a new Soquel record in the 120-yard high hurdles, which he won with a 14.9 time. Sambrillo went 14 1/4 to win the pole vault, while teammate Richard Munoz nabbed second place with a 12-7/4 vault. Third went to Marelo Prep's lone varsity qualifier, Kevin King, who vaulted 12-1/4.

Also taking a varsity second was Santa Cruz High's Allen Sandretti, who set an SCSH record in the two-mile run with a 9:38.6 clocking.

Soquel's Phil Kitchen tied his previous personal best time in the 120 highs (15.3) and took home third place, good for a section qualifying berth. Third in the 880 was SLV's Eric Lindsey, clocked at 1:59.2.

Two more Harbor athletes rounded out the area's varsity qualifiers.

Jim Leonard's 50-8 1/4 shot put was good for third place, as was Steve Gidding's 40.5 time in the 330-yard low hurdles.

As expected Monterey eased to the regional varsity title, scoring 53 points to runnerup Seaside's 45. The highest finish among county teams was Soquel and Watsonville's 14 points, good for a sixth place tie.

Soquel nabbed second place in frosh-soph competition, scoring 29 points behind runaway winner Palma, which had 40.

Aiding Soquel's cause were two first place finishes.

Greg Munoz ran the 330-yard low hurdles in 40.7, and the Knights' one-mile relay team established a seasonal best time of 3:57.4 while winning. Louis Fusari, Matt Cattani, Greg Munoz and Gerry Capron comprised the team.

Capron took second in the 880-yard run in 2:05.5, as did teammate Neil Thelen, who went 41-10 in the triple jump. Also nabbing second places and section spots were Marelo's John Starr, who went 47-6 1/4 in the shotput and San Lorenzo Valley's Rackley, who had a

107-second place time in the 100-yard dash.

Starr also qualified in the discus, taking third place with a 135-10 heave. Gerry Capron added another qualifying event with his third in the 440-yard dash (53.6). Soquel's Gordon McLean had a third place 10.08.6 two-mile, while teammate John Dillon took third in the high jump with a personal best of 6-0.

His previous best was 5-8.

Aptos' Rob Stanford ran 330 lows in 41.8 for third place, and Watsonville's Skipper Valencia (12-2 in the pole vault) and Danny Ventura (44.2 in the mile) also nabbed third spots.

Watsonville's other frosh-soph qualifiers were Rene Villenuova and Mike Severin, who won the 880 and pole vault with respective marks of 2:04.0 and 12-8.

The sectional finals will be this Friday afternoon and evening at San Jose City College.
