Visit the unique downtown mall, a center for shoppers, art shows and live entertainment. Or cross the Willamette to browse through the air-conditioned Valley River Shopping Center... alive with exciting choices.

Don't miss the view from Skinner's Butte, a tour of Lane Community College or a stroll through the University of Oregon campus and its art museum filled with treasures such as the priceless jade pagoda... only one of its kind in the world.

You might enjoy the open air Saturday Market or the newly opened Fifth Street Public Market selling baked goods, fresh produce and handcrafted items by skilled artisans from forested hills. Or dine by candlelight in a leisurely-paced atmosphere of complete relaxation and enjoyment.

Do you play tennis? Tuck the rackets in the car. Some motels have courts. Many public courts are available. Golf? There are eleven golf courses within thirty minutes of downtown Eugene.

Plan to take along your bicycle. You will be delighted with more than eleven miles of bike trails **totally separated** from auto traffic. One route extends four miles down the shore of the beautiful Willamette.

Within ninety minutes of driving you can reach more than 35 overnight campgrounds in addition to dozens of picnic sites neatly tucked away in friendly forests. High in the Cascades the backpacker is challenged by mountain trails and breath-taking vistas.

... and the jogger should know that **Eugene is Track City U.S.A.!** There is plenty of room to go jogging along paths that are free from yapping dogs and startled onlookers.

If you bring your camera, and you **should**, you will be delighted with our Rhododendron Gardens, the bright, flower carpeted fairgrounds or a tour by special arrangement through Chase Gardens... nationally famous for commercial flowers.

For information on athletic or cultural events check with the Chamber of Commerce as soon as you arrive. There are plays, art shows, concerts, lectures and musicals. Antique hunters love it here. Did you know that our county still has 21 covered bridges?

The railroad buff will be charmed by the 25 mile train ride up Row River past tuck-away valleys and hidden farms. The starting point is Cottage Grove, just 20 minutes south.

Now, about weather... July through September the temperature averages a little over 64 degrees and the nights are cool. Bring something warm. In July or August there may be 3 days with a trace of rain. June and September each average 1 1/4 inches of rain. Bring a raincoat.
