POLAND v CANADA v UNITED KINGDOM JULY 3RD/4TH - Crystal Palace

Though the match gave the U.K. its first ever victory over the Polish mens team, the spotlight was on the individuals for whom it was the last ~~race~~ competitive effort for many of them before they left for Montreal.

The most exciting race was the 400m which matched two ex-European Champions - Jan Werner (69) & Dave Jenkins (71). Werner entered the straight clear but Jenkins fought hard and they went through the line together. Jenkins (451 the previous week) just got the verdict as both clocked 45.65.

Alan Pascoe, upset by numerous injuries had a successful first 400m outing of the season, but the time (50.62) will hardly worry Aki Bua & Moses.

Brendan Foster suffered a surprise defeat at the hands of Canadian Dave Hill in the 1500m But his 5th last lap means he won't lose much in a sprint finish at Montreal.

Other medal prospects, Capes (Shot), Obett (800) Slusarski (P.V) all had easy victories.

Nick Rose, regrettably not going to Montreal, showed he's a better 5000m runner than Dave Black who is going. After a very slow start (2.53/5.57/8.50), Black kicked in a 59.3 leaving only Rose & Grant McLaren. A 62.3 left just Rose. With 900m left, Rose flew by Black completing the next 2 laps in 62.4 & 62.5 (4.06.8, 1600 betw 3200m & 4800m) and Rose just jogged down the straight (34 last 200). In the Steeplechase, Rose's Western Kentucky colleague Tony Staynings got a P.R. 8.28.6 thanks to a 62.9 last 400 ending up 6 seconds behind ^{Bronislaw} Malnowski who leded very easy up front.

In the womens events the highlights were Sonia Lannamers 11.28/22.86 Sprint double and the 800 where Yvonne Saunders struggled past a very tired Elzbieta Katolik in the straight after the Pole did a 56.9 first 400.
