THIS IS THE MEET where USC and UCLA fans can compare strengths and weaknesses of each team as they look forward to the crosstown classic '76 coming up in a month, Saturday, May 1, here in Drake Stadium. Naturally, the fans also are interested in seeing how Stanford and Cal shape up this year. This is the first of two exciting Pac-8 dual meet doubleheaders, the second scheduled in two weeks from today, April 17, at Stanford, with the Cardinals hosting the Bruins and the Bears facing the Trojans.

Scoring for Today's Dual Meets: 5 - 3 - 1 for individual events; 5 - 0 for relay races. Total points for 15 individual events and two relays are 145. Winner of each meet must score more than 72 1/2 points.

SEASON RESULTS TO DATE:... Stanford, USC and UCLA come into today's competition with undefeated dual meet records while California has split two duals. Stanford won a triangular opener with 116 points to 77 for Cal State Hayward and 9 for Santa Clara and scored a 95-68 dual victory over Fresno State. The Cardinals also competed in their own Stanford Relays, a non-scoring affair. USC (4-0) has swept to victories over UC Irvine, 113-40; Cal State Northridge, 137-16; Arizona, 116-29; and Arizona State, 95-50. UCLA also has won four duals, to date, including Arizona State, 80-65; San Jose State, 86-59; Tennessee, 77-72; and Long Beach State, 94-51. Incidentally, the Bruins have now won 39 straight dual meet victories over a five-season span and are looking for No. 40 against Cal this afternoon. The Bears have defeated San Diego State, 78-67, while losing to Arizona State, 80-65, and also have participated in two non-scoring affairs at Sacramento State and Stanford Relays.

Drake Stadium records are for metric distances while Stanford-USC and California-UCLA dual meet records are for linear distances. Lifetime and 1976 best performances are listed in parentheses for Stanford (S), USC, California (C) and UCLA entries where available, with "m" indicating metric times and "y" indicating clockings made at linear distances:

100 — 9.6 for yards and 10.3 for meters. **220** — 21.4 and 21.3. **440** — 48.0 and 47.7. **880** — 1:52.0 and 1:51.3. **MILE** — 4:08.0 and 3:51.0. **THREE-MILE** — 14:10.0 and 14:40.0. **SIX-MILE** — No standard required. **HIGH HURDLES** — 14.4 and 14.4. **INTERMEDIATE HURDLES** — 53.0 and 52.7. **440 AND MILE RELAYS** — No standards required. **DECATHLON** — 6,800 points. **SHOT PUT** — 57-0. **DISCUS THROW** — 170-0. **JAVELIN THROW** — 220. **POLE VAULT** — 15-9. **LONG JUMP** — 24-6. **TRIPLE JUMP** — 49-6. **HIGH JUMP** — 6-10. **HAMMER THROW** — 160-0.

Owens, UCLA's great high hurdler, was sprinting for the first time as a Bruin and really impressed. He had a busy day, running the opening leg on the 400-meter relay and also winning his specialty, the highs, in fast time of 13.8. Wilson also had a good day, winning the 200-meter dash in his fastest clocking of 20.8 (wind-aided) after being nipped by Owens in the century.
