SALINAS — The favorites didn't necessarily wind up as winners in the Monterey Bay League's last championship track and field meet at Hartnell College Saturday.
 It was a day of big surprises as well, the biggest being Don Coulter's failure to show for the varsity 440. The Harbor High senior is now ineligible to compete in any more post-season 440 races, but there's a way "out." The 11 MBL track coaches at the meet held an impromptu meeting at the Hartnell oval to discuss the incident, and voted — by a mere 6-5 margin — to try to get Coulter in this Friday's region meet, if possible. It wasn't immediately clear who voted for the proposal or who voted against it.
 Coulter is (or was) a definite threat to the state title, but could not run in Friday's region meet without bumping out another runner. The MBL is only allowed to send five runners to regionals. Coulter makes six.
 Mike Hamm of Soquel pulled off the day's biggest upset when he stole the 120 high hurdles. Hamm had never run the 120 highs before this season and trimmed sixth tenths of a second off his best time in winning. Curtis Sells was second to

Hamm's 14.9 with a 15.0. Phil Kitchen of Soquel was third.
 A very pumped-up Seaside 440 relay team won its race with a time of 43.0. Seaside always has strong relay teams which seem to peak in the big meets.
 Seaside also won the coveted team trophy, as the Spartans edged out Soquel by a mere five points, 49-44. The chase for the team title lasted all day long, with the lead changing every couple of events.
 Ted Peterson got people asking who the kid with the green tank top was after he was a surprise winner in the 880 with a sharp 1:56.6 clocking. Pre-meet favorites Gerry Capron, Tim Hoffman (Soquel) and Rene Villanueva (Watsonville) finished two, three, and four, respectively.
 Seaside coach Nat Dozier gambled and put hurdler LeCharles McDaniel in the 100-yard dash; the move paid off when McDaniel won the sprint in 10.3. Juan Torres of Soquel came within inches of winning the race, finishing second with an identical 10.3.
 Mike Breaux won the Coulter-less 440 with a 49.8 clocking. Sandy Houston of SLV was fifth at 51.4.
 Rudy Munoz from Watsonville took an early lead and made it stick in the two-mile.

The Wildcat distance ace ran a personal best 9:33.1.
 McDaniel also won the 330 low hurdles, tying his own meet record at 38.8. Greg Munoz, one of many Soquel High spikers who competed in numerous events in hopes of helping the Knights' team chances, was second at a school record 39.2.
 Coulter did make it to the track on time for the 220. Coulter's best race is the 440, which he won Saturday with a 21.5 meet record time. Once again, Torres finished in the second spot.
 Jerry Lowmiller of Salinas won the mile, fighting off Armando Sequeros of Watsonville to stop the watches at 4:26.5.
 Seaside completed a sweep of the relay events by taking the mile shuttle with a 3:24.6. Soquel really needed to beat Seaside in order to win the team title, but the Knights came in fourth.
 Randy Wilson of North Salinas doubled in the weightmen's events, taking the shot put with a 53-8 throw and the discus at 165-7 1/2. Hamm was second in the discus with a heave of 163-0.
 Genaro Alcantara of Watsonville broke a meet record set in 1963, a school record set in 1932,

and posted one of the CCS' best distances when he leaped 23-2 1/2 in the long jump.
 Ron Johnson of Monterey won the triple jump with a distance of 46-1/2. Sells won the high jump at 6-2. Barry Leaman of Harbor also jumped 6-2, but lost on the basis that he had missed more jumps than Sells.
 North Salinas won the frosh-soph team title with 42 1/2 points. Soquel once again had to settle for second place with 42 points, a half of a point shy.
 Andre Wilkes had an outstanding day in frosh-soph competition, leading the Santa Cruz 440 relay team to a first place finish with a great anchor leg. Wilkes also won the 100 and 220 for himself. The Cards finished fourth as a team. Rob Munro of
