

# 25 CCS Spikers

**BERKELEY** — The California Interscholastic Federation Track & Field Championships started here Friday with the usual number of surprises and disappointments and the Central Coast Section had some of both.

The biggest disappointment among CCS athletes involved Piedmont Hills' Keith Taylor, who won his heat of the 440-yard dash with an impressive 47.9 only to be disqualified for running out of his lane.

Taylor's 47.9 was the fastest of the day, and it came between two brilliant relay anchors which got Piedmont Hills second places and into today's finals.

A total of 15 boys from the CCS

qualified for 16 berths along with three relay teams—Piedmont Hills in both and Mount Pleasant in the 440.

Ten girls from the CCS qualified for today's finals, including Marquita Belk of Silver Creek who

won her heat of the 440 in 56.7, and Lezli Peterson of Harbor who was second in hers in 57.3.

Kris Costello of Lynbrook won her heat of the 80-yard low hurdles in 10.9, equalling the time of another heat winner but slower than the 10.7 recorded by Merced's Tuti Lee.

Andre Phillips, the Silver Creek junior running with a painful hamstring, was the lone CCS athlete to take a heat in the boys division. He scurried over the 330-yard low hurdles in 37.3.

Phillips ran surprisingly well on the turn, finding himself in front heading into the straightaway and he eased into the tape. Only Chris Koko (Sunset of Hayward), who took the second heat in 37.2, ran faster than Phillips.

Tom Light of Pacific Grove didn't win his 880 race, but he finished strong along with two others who were all clocked in 1:54.8.

Bruce Stirling of Oakland High, Chris Powell of Pt. Loma and Light were picked in that order but all were credited with the same time.

The CCS Boys were shut out of qualifiers in four events.

Field event finals start today at 12:30 and the first track final is set for 1:30.
