# Furman Leads 'Southern' Meet

GREENVILLE, S.C. (AP)— Chris Borch and Brad Hiles each won a first place Friday as Furman took the lead after the first day of the 53rd annual Southern Conference track and field championships.

The Paladins accumulated 45 points, followed by VMI with 40.

The favorite, East Carolina, was able to get only 13 points in the five finals events, with 15 other winners to be decided Saturday, including the sprints in which the Pirates are strongest.

Borch won the 10,000 meters, while

Hiles picked up a victory in the hammer throw. The Paladins also got a second place in the long jump from Carl Anderson, and a second and a third in the 3,000-meter steeplechase from Phil Barker and John Cole.

Andre Gibson of VMI won the long jump, while VMI's Rex Wiggins captured the 3,000-meter steeplechase.

Appalachian State's Dave Markland set a conference record in the javelin with a toss of 229 feet 8 inches.

## East Carolina Edges Furman 1

GREENVILLE, S.C. (AP)— Calvin Alston, named the outstanding performer of the meet, led defending champion East Carolina to the championship Saturday in the 53rd annual Southern Conference track and field championships. Furman finished second.

The Pirates finished with a team total of 128 points, while the Paladins accumulated 125 points.

ECU, which was heavily favored, trailed Furman until the late stages of the meet, when their depth in the sprint events began to tell.

The Pirates got a first and second place in the 100 meters from Alston and Otis Melvin, and captured the first three places in the 200 meters, with Alston getting first, Melvin second and Carter Suggs third.

In the 400 meters, East Carolina took second place with Jay Purdie, fourth place from

Terry Perry, fifth from Charlie Moss and sixth place from James Freeman.

Furman led with just three events left, but East Carolina won the mile relay and freshman Eddie Bailey took a second in the discus to wrap up the victory.

Furman Coach Bill Keesling was named track coach of the year.

Alston won the 100-meter and the 200-meter sprints.
