

Girls Qualify

—Records Fall

In All Events

Susan Springer, Kris Costello and Marquita Belk were among the brightest stars on the Central Coast Section girls track and field scene a year ago and are primed for the same roles Friday night in the section championships at San Jose City College.

Each of them sparkled in the qualifying meet Saturday on the City College oval where meet records were broken in every event.

Miss Costello, a junior at Lynbrook, ran 24.3 in the 220 prelims for a record and 14.25 over the 110-yard low hurdles for another mark and had a hand in another when she helped the 440 relay team clock 49.3.

Springer and Belk, sophs at Salinas and Silver Creek, respectively, were just as impressive. Springer lofted the shot 42-0½ and tossed the discus a lifetime best of 136-3, second best effort in the state this season. Belk broke her own 440 mark with a 56.9 and helped her mile relay unit set another with a 4:05.3 effort.
