Knights' Graber in high jump best

Bill Graber can't jump over buildings in a single bound, but he can still outjump just about anyone in the Central Coast Section.

Graber, a junior at Los Altos High School, high jumped 6-9½ Thursday to set a school record and at the same time posted the best jump in the section this year.

Graber's jump highlighted Los Altos' tri-meet win over Santa Clara Valley league opponent Wilcox and Cupertino of the De Anza Athletic League.

In other SCVAL meets, Buchser topped Palo Alto 89-46, Santa Clara knocked off Cubberley 73-63, Awalt ripped Mountain View 85-25 and Gunn topped Peterson 86-49.

The 100-yard dash provided the day's big thrills.

Santa Clara's Mike Skinner ran a 10.1 to beat Cubberley's Bill Green in what was Green's first league loss of the year.

Jeff Moses of Cubberley ran 39.8 in the 330 low hurdles in one of the league's fastest times for that race this year.

Mountain View came up winless for the fourth time in a row, but coach Tom Bissell is encouraged with his freshman and junior varsity teams. The Eagles' underclassmen have posted a combined record of 9-0-1 this year.

At the Cupertino tri-meet, a special AAU discus competition was

held and was won by Jim McGoldrick with a throw of 213-1, the second best throw in the world this year. Former world record holder John Powell finished second with a throw of 208-2.
