Soquel Frosh-Soph King In Region IV Spikefest

SALINAS — Soquel High's Rick Ifland and Eric Bentley both set meet records here Saturday at the Region IV track and field meet to help the Knights to the frosh-soph team title with 70 points.

Ifland broke a four-year old mark in the 800 with a 1:59.8 timing, which also established a school record, while Bentley snapped Soquel's Louis Fusari's record in the 330 low hurdles with a time of 40.3.

Ifland also crossed the line first in the mile with a 4:32.9 time.

Santa Cruz High's Andre Wilkes was the only other SCCAL double winner, streaking to a 10.0 time in the 100 and

a 22.0 clocking in the 220.

Harbor High's Ted Peterson, who came out of the unknown to win last year's 880, took it again this year, crossing the line in 1:57.4 after grabbing second in the SCCAL finals to Soquel's Gerry Capron.

Peterson also cleared the bar in the high jump at 6-2, the same as winner Joey Maggini of King City, who had fewer misses to give him the nod.

Soquel High came home one-two in the 330 low hurdles with Greg Munoz stopping the watches at 39.0 and teammate Jimmy Verdusco clocked at 39.0 also, and the judges' decision going in Munoz' favor.

Knight frosh-soph phenom

Robert East set a school record in the 220 with a 22.8 time — eight-tenths of a second better than last week's SCCAL time.

Bob Baul rounded out the list of Soquel firsts with a 13-6 top mark in the varsity pole vault, six inches better than his closest pursuer.

Aptos' Bob Schindler brought in the best 440 time of the day with a 49.6, almost two seconds better than his 51.3 first in the SCCAL finals.

A pair of Santa Cruz High frosh-soph standouts — Bob Sanders and John Rembao — both took firsts, with the former clocking a 9.2 in the 70 high hurdles and the latter chopping over 40 seconds off his time of last week with a 9:56.2 in the two mile.
