

KING LEAPS 26-6 1/2; IRVINE WINS TITLE

FRESNO (AP)—Lamonte King, a UC Irvine freshman from Surprise, Ariz., leaped to a world's best long jump of the year Saturday, 26 feet 6 1/2 inches at the 10th annual Pacific Coast Athletic Assn. track and field championships.

King, 5-9 and 160 pounds, made his conference record jump after winning the 100 and 200-meter dashes to become the first triple winner in the history of the meet. He ran the 200 in a meet-record 20.61 and the 100 in a track record 10.46.

The three victories led Irvine's Anteaters, competing for the first time in the PCAA meet, to the team championship with 89 points to 76 1/2 for Long Beach State and 70 for defending champion San Jose State.

Irvine's Steve Scott ran a meet-record 3:43.6 in the 1,500 meters and teammate Mauricio Bardales set a PCAA record of 7.485 points in the decathlon.
