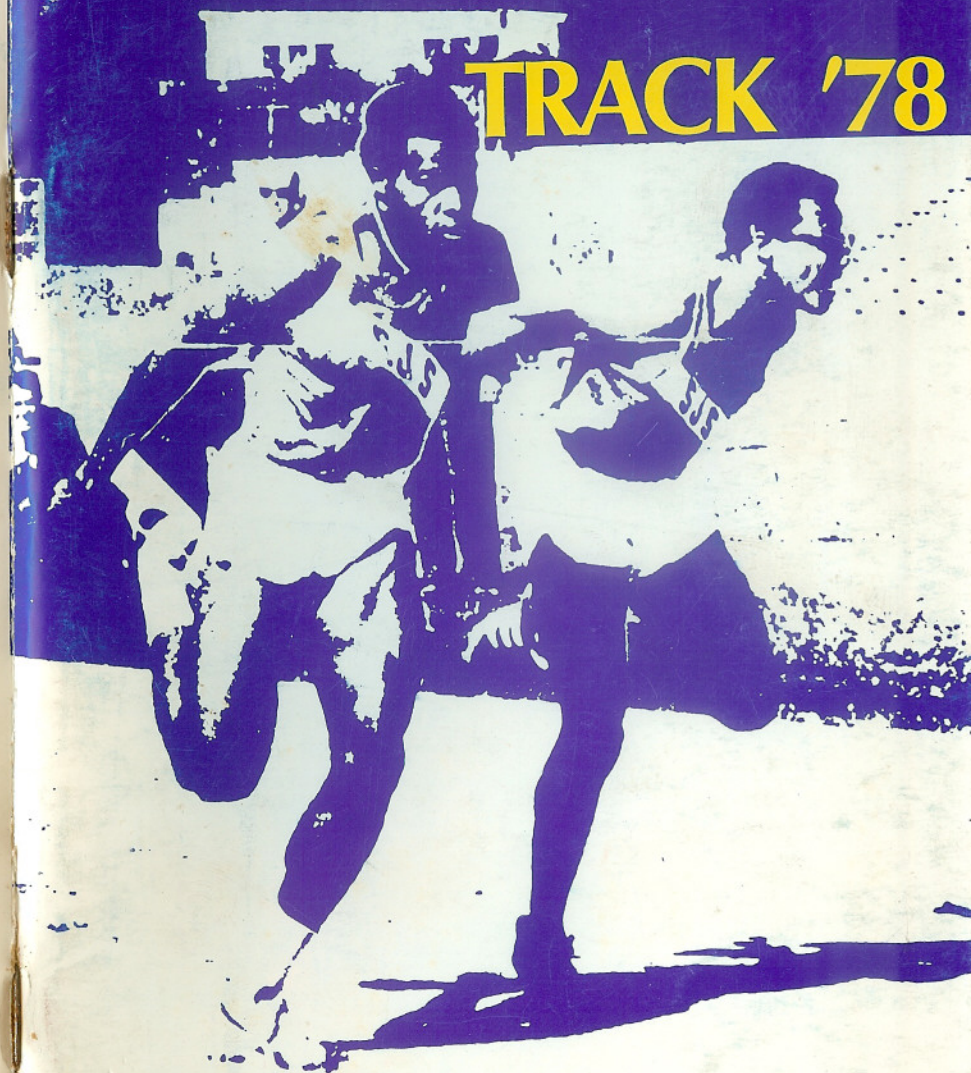

1978 OUTLOOK: A NATIONAL POWER AGAIN

It's a good bet that San Jose State University will dent the NCAA's 'Super Dozen' for the fourth time in as many years at the annual championship event hosted by the University of Oregon this spring.

To get there, SJSU will use a blend of experienced talent and fresh talent to provide depth, excitement and strength at nearly every event.

"The middle distances will be a vital key aspect to our 1978 program. There isn't much pure physical talent here but what our athletes lack in tools is compensated by their toughness and determination and willingness to work . . ." Bullard says.

Many new faces here but the group is led by returnees Lupe Chavez and Russ Nahirny.

LONG DISTANCES

"Like the middle distance areas, the longer distances will be an important part of our 1978 effort. Again the situation is the same as in the middle distances with not much physical talent but it is a truly tough and determined group . . ." according to Bullard.

Experience reigns here with Dan Harvey pacing the pack.

JUMPS

"Quality and depth is apparent in most areas of SJSU's jumping events. The only possible weak spot here could be the long jump . . . the potential is there but the experience is lacking . . ." Bullard.

The big name in this area is Ron Livers, the collegiate record holder and two-time NCAA triple jump champion. He is a world class competitor. All the faces are familiar since all are returnees. Greg Woepse is another standout here.

HEAD COACH ERNIE BULLARD



Entering his eighth season at the helm of one of America's top collegiate track and field powers, Ernie Bullard looks forward with great anticipation to his 1978 crop of San Jose State Spartans.

The head coach came to San Jose State in 1968 from Mesa Community College in Mesa, Arizona, where his '68 squad won the National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) crown. While at Mesa, Bullard coached several NJCAA individual champions, American JC record holders and a

few Olympians.

Prior to his successful stint in Arizona, Bullard served as head track coach at Orange Coast Community College in California.

Since coming to Sparta, Bullard has guided his charges to NCAA finishes of 14th in 1971, 35th in 1973, 4th in 1975, 9th in 1976 and 12th last spring. His teams have won four Pacific Coast Athletic Association (PCAA) titles and placed second three other times in the past seven seasons. SJSU was league champion in 1973, 1974, 1975 and in 1977.

San Jose has been rated by TRACK & FIELD NEWS as Nos. 6, 13, 7, 7 and 5 from 1973 through 1977 in the nation among dual-meet powers.

SJSU has earned an overall mark of 68-16 in dual meets since 1971 including a perfect 15-0 mark in 1973 and an impeccable record of 10-0 last year.

Recognized as one of the top pole vault coaches in the world, Bullard graduated from the University of Southern California in 1959. He placed fourth in the NCAA meet in that event as a collegian.

He earned his Masters of Science from Arizona State University in 1961. Among his other honors, Bullard was coach of the US Junior Olympic team in 1975, has guided teams on several international tours and has written four books on field event techniques.

DISTANCE & WEIGHT COACH DON RIGGS



In his sixth season with San Jose State University, cross country, distance and weight coach Don Riggs' contribution to the Spartan 'Spikesters scene' has been immeasurable.

He was named to the SJSU staff in 1972 following a similar coaching stint at the University of Oregon. Riggs has turned the distance program around at San Jose State.

He is one of the finest 'on the field' coaches in the nation and in the area of technical knowledge, Riggs has the respect of the key people in the collegiate cinder circles. Riggs' charges have all but rewritten the books on distance running marks at San Jose and his runners have always been ready to compete against SJSU's rough dual meet slate. The same is true for San Jose's weight program under Riggs.

He attended Eastern Washington State and received his B.A. in physical education before moving on to Central University for his M.A. In 1969, he capped his education with a Ph.D. from the University of Oregon.

Much of the structure and success of San Jose's track and field program is owed to Don Riggs' efforts and coach Ernie Bullard will be the first to praise him so.



SPRINT & HURDLE COACH LARRY LIVERS



Along with Don Riggs, sprint and hurdle coach Larry Livers joined the San Jose State University track and field staff in the fall of 1972.

Probably the staff's top recruiter, Larry uses sound principals and approaches toward coaching the sprinters and hurdlers and immediate rapport to recruit those athletes to SJSU.

He was hired by San Jose State to rebuild the lost "Speed City" era of the last 1960's as overseer of the sprint and hurdle corps. He did so immediately and has been plugging away at that goal ever since. This year's sprinters and hurdlers may just be the best in many years at Sparta.

Livers, whose brother Ron is a world class athlete with the Spartans track and field troops, is one of the important assets at SJSU. His range of talent affords him respect in every corner of not only the university but the entire US track and field world.

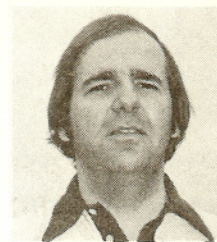

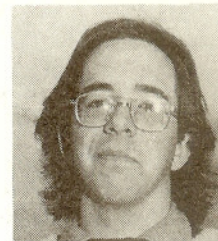

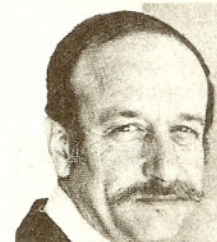

SAN JOSE STATE UNIVERSITY

San Jose State University, California's oldest public institution of higher education, traces its beginnings to 1857 — just seven years after statehood and four years before the Civil War.

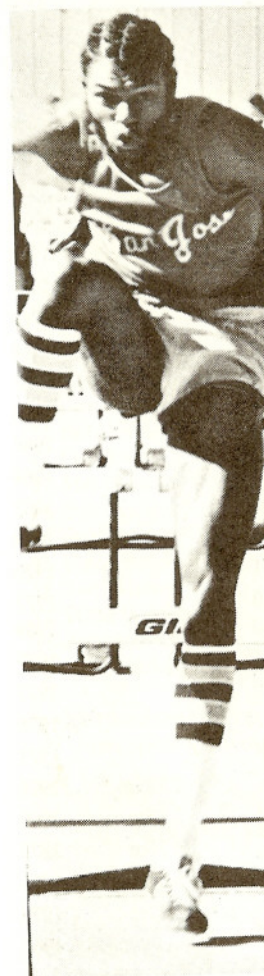
SJSU began in 1857 as **Minns' Evening Normal School** for teacher preparation and the first student body numbered "one gentleman and five ladies."

In 1862, the university was renamed **California State Normal School**. Because of San Francisco's rough-and-tumble environment back then, the school was moved in 1871 to its Washington Square campus and was called **San Jose State Normal School**.

Following fires which destroyed original wooden structures, the cornerstone of the present main building — whose ivy-covered Tower Hall is the university's symbol — was laid on June 23, 1909.

In 1921, the normal schools of California became teachers' colleges and two years later, **San Jose State Teachers' College** awarded its first A.B. degree. As the school expanded services into liberal arts and other occupational fields, the name was changed to **San Jose State College** in 1935. Finally, on June 1, 1972, the name was changed to **San Jose State University**, reflecting the increased diversity of its eight schools and 70 departments.

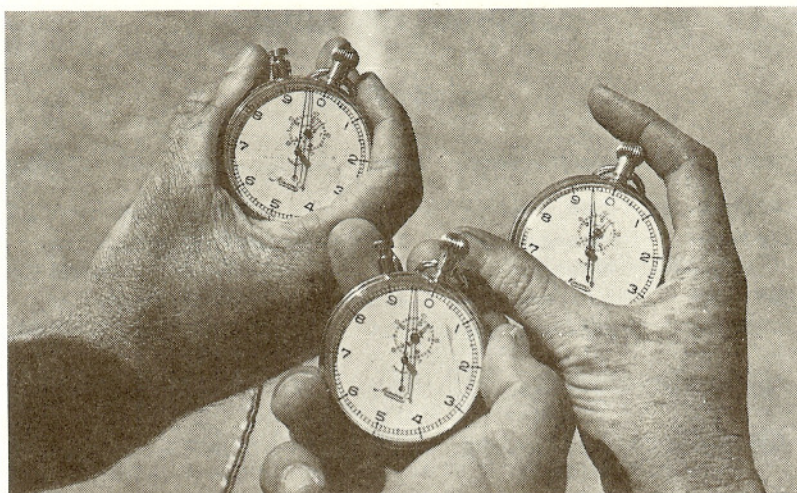

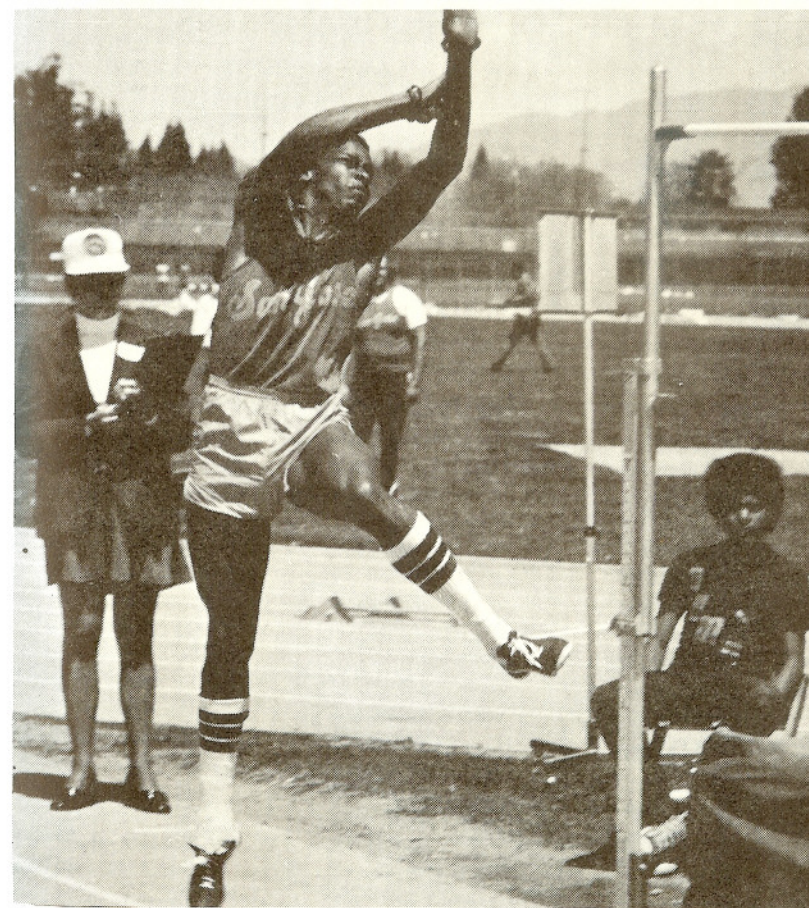
