

## Cooper triumphs

# Coghlan sets record

SAN DIEGO (AP) — Ireland's Eamonn Coghlan set a new European indoor record by winning the mile in 3:56.0 in the 12th annual San Diego Invitational Track Meet at the Sports Arena Friday night.

With 180 yards to go, AAU champion Steve Scott challenged for the lead but Coghlan's kick held him off while Tanzania's Filbert Bayi slippey back to third. Scott was timed in 3:57.1 and Bayi clocked 3:59.7.

"I wasn't really thinking of beating Bayi," said Coghlan. "I had beaten him twice or three times earlier this year so that wasn't on my mind."

Tanzania's Suleiman Nyambui ran the fastest time ever on an 11-lap track to win the two-mile run in 8:17.9. Nick Rose of Great Britain was second in 8:18.4 and Kenyan Henry Rono of Washington State was third in 8:20.0

LeNorris Marshall of Surprise, Ariz., just outside of Phoenix, scored a stunning upset in the 60-yard dash. Marshall, a 17-year-old senior at Dysart High, was clocked in 6.26 seconds.

Steve Williams finished second in 6.27 seconds, followed by Jamaica's Don Quarrie in 6.29. Wilbert Gregory was fourth.

Dedy Cooper of San Jose State, who is unbeaten this year, flashed to an easy victory in the 60-yard high hurdles in 7.18 seconds. Mike Johnson was second in 7.38 and Tony

Hicks was third in 7.45.

World record-holder Mary Decker failed in her bid to become the first woman to run the half-mile under two minutes indoors, but she breezed to an easy 10-second victory in 2:03.5, the best time indoors this year.

Former world record-holder Dwight Stones won the high jump by clearing 7-4 but in the pole vault Mike Tully bowed out at 17 feet. Wladyslaw Kosakiewicz of Poland won with a 17-7 effort.

Herman Frazier of the Philadelphia Pioneer Club won the 500-yard dash in 55.9 and Arnie Robinson of the San Diego Ghetto Striders set a meet record with a personal best leap of 26-9/4 to win the long jump.

Favored Francie Larrieu of the Pacific Coast Club won the women's mile in 4:35.4.
