

76ers' Bier shatters 2-mile state standard

The Mt. Hamilton League showed again Friday why it's considered the best track league in the area.

Eight Central Coast Section bests were bettered or tied in the Mt. Hamilton meet at San Jose City College, some of them by huge margins. No team scores were kept in the meet.

The best time of the evening was turned in by Independence's Roxanne Bier, who ran a state-best 10:39.6 for the 76ers in the girls' two-mile. Bier's time is exactly four seconds better than the previous state best run by Susie Meek of Palos Verdes.

Overfelt's Dwayne Taylor ran two super, albeit wind-aided, sprints, but in the 100 he still couldn't catch Mt. Pleasant's Rod Dawkins despite running a 9.6. Dawkins also was timed in 9.6, a meet record.

Taylor did, however, take the 220 in a CCS

best time of 21.3, bettering the 21.4 run earlier by Bill Green of Cubberley.

Other CCS bests in the boys' competition were by Mt. Pleasant's 440 relay (42.4, bettering its own CCS best of 42.5), Troy Durio of Mt. Pleasant in the 330 low hurdles (37.4, blistering the previous best by .7) and Overfelt's mile relay (3:20.5, improving on San Carlos' 3:21.52).

The girls' meet was even more proficient, believe it or not, at breaking meet records. Only three of the 13 events were not victimized by record-breakers, and two other CCS bests were set besides Bier's super two-mile.

Hill eclipsed the CCS best in the 440 relay with its time of 48.0, and Ayer's Tammy Sullivan went a wind-aided 17-9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in the long jump to set another CCS mark. Sullivan also won the 220 in a meet-record 24.9.

In the West Catholic League meet, St. Ignatius showed conclusively that it's still the best team in that league. The Wildcats, who had their dual-meet streak busted by Bellarmine earlier this spring, outscored the second-place Bells by a whopping 67 points, 162-95.

In the Santa Teresa League meet Thursday night, Gilroy won the boys' championship and Leland took the girls' title.

St. Ignatius runs away with a title

Seniors Phil McCarty of St. Francis High and Andy Damonte of Serra won championships with life bests Friday night in the West Catholic Athletic League track and field finals at Foothill College.

McCarty took the mile in 4:27.0, one of the better efforts in St. Francis history, while Damonte captured the 440 in 51.4, well ahead of the field.

St. Ignatius, which lost by two points in a dual meet to Bellarmine, easily won the official WCAL championship with 162 points. The Bells made their best showing in years with 95. Serra, only fifth in the WCAL dual season, finished third with 73, followed by Riordan and St. Francis.

McCarty was St. Francis' lone winner. Bellarmine's Art Lemos won the 880 in 1:59.6 and teamed with Ed Bengier, Mike Marr and Troy Forte to take the mile relay in 3:29.8.

The three San Francisco schools, led by double hurdles winner Charles Williams of SI, won 11 of the 16 varsity events.

In the frosh-soph finals, St. Francis freshman Dave Sweeney won both hurdles while freshman Scott Gale took the mile in a 4:37.6 and Lancer sophomore Mike Norman won the high and triple jumps.

Riordan edged St. Francis for the frosh-soph title, 130-118.
