Johnson Sets Record; Banning Wins City Title

Philip Johnson of Gardena defended his 120-yard high hurdles title with a record run Saturday in the City track and field championships at East LA College.

A crowd of 4,500 watched Johnson run a City record 13.64, which broke the mark (13.8) he shared with Ted Knighten of Fremont (1973). Banning High won the team title.

It was Johnson's career best (he had run a 13.66 in winning last year's State meet) and he did it despite a "bad" start and making contact seven times with Tony Campbell of Banning, who finished second in 13.88.

"I had a bad start," Johnson said. "I figured on somebody jumping. I got out fair but not as good as I wanted. Then, Tony (Campbell) kept hitting my lead hand. After being hit at least four times, I just poured it on."

While Johnson was quite casual and relaxed after the race, Campbell was quite upset. He denied hitting the City champ and accused Johnson of the interference.

"I'm disappointed," he said. "Especially when I had a chance to beat him, but he came out and hit me. He knocked me off balance and threw my timing off. I was going too high over the hurdles. I'll get him. We still have the State meet to go."

The top four finishers in each event qualify for the State meet next Friday and Saturday in Bakersfield.

In other action at East LA, Donnie Butler of Fremont successfully defended his long jump title with a career best jump of 25-4. Butler, who jumped 24-4 3/4 in last year's meet, jumped 25-1 on an earlier jump and easily finished ahead of Fremont's Mike Bradford who also had a career best (24-3 1/2).

In the final running event of the day, Banning's mile relay team set a City record of 3:15.6 in helping the Pilots walk away with its first City track championship with 67 points, 21 points ahead of second-place Gardena.

Fremont led by a few yards after the second hand off, but Darryl Davis (47.7) and anchorman Deven Lewis (47.8) put Banning in control. Chris Blaylock (49.5) and San Caesar (50.6) ran the first two legs.

Valerie Brisco helped Locke win the girls team title with 41 points.

Brisco, the nation's leading runner in the 100 (10.5), 220 (23.7) and 440 (53.9), took firsts in all three events and anchored the city's fastest mile relay team.

Brisco ran a city record 24.10 in the 220, a wind-aided 10.76 in the 100 and a 55.97 in the 440. The mile relay team also set a City record with a time of 3:55.5. The old mark (3:57.5) was set by the same team last year.

Westchester, which finished second in the team title race, set a City record in the 440 relay with time of 47.89. Gwen Loud, the nation's leading long jumper, anchored the team, but pulled a hamstring in the 100 and ended up only qualifying with the 440 relay team.

"If she'd been able to compete, we would've won it (the team title)," said Loud's coach Pat Nordell. "We're hoping she will be able to run in the 440 relay next week (in the State meet)."
