Foothill sets Kiwanis meet

It will be one heck of a big track meet.

It's the 17th Annual Kiwanis Invitational Track and Field meet a week from Saturday at Foothill College, where more than 100 schools from Northern California will participate.

Last year's meet attracted 73 high schools and more than 2,000 athletes. This year will be even bigger, according to co-directors Hank Ketels and Leo Long.

Many top local athletes will be showcased, including high jumper Bill Graber, who leaped 6-9½ last year and has already jumped 6-8 in an all-comers track meet this spring.

Rain shouldn't hamper the meet. Foothill has an artificial track, a tartan runway, which allows competition in spite of heavy rain. "We're 99% sure we will have the meet," Long said. "It will have to rain hard all day long to stop it."

The meet is scheduled to start at 10 a.m. with the varsity events and hurdle trials. It will run all day to about 5:30 p.m., concluding with the varsity one-mile relay.

Kiwanis prep meet attracts stampede

If big means good, Saturday's 17th Annual Kiwanis Invitational Track and Field Meet should be one of the top events of the year.

More than 2,000 athletes from 62 Northern California high schools will participate in the all-day competition at Foothill College.

The first trials will start at 10 a.m. with the finals expected to start at about 4 p.m. The meet is directed by Hank Ketels of Foothill College and Leo Long of Los Altos High.

Many 1977 meet record holders will be back to defend their achievements. Among them will be Lee Evans and Rick Brown, who both clocked 48.1 in last year's 440-yard dash.

But the competition is thick. Stan Beal of San Carlos (48.7), Bill Green of Cubberley (49.0), Bob Menoe from Del Mar (49.9) and Derrick Carter from Mt. Pleasant (49.7) should make it one of the top races in the meet.

The 120 high hurdles race may see a new record set.

Malcom Dixon of Sequoia (14.2),

Tony Durio of Mt. Pleasant (14.4), Steve Guthrie of Cupertino (14.5), Kenneth Davieson of Willits (14.5) and Kent Wheat of Mountain View (14.8) will challenge the record clocking of 14.2, set by Carl Florant of Palo Alto.

Carlos Carrasco from Mt. Pleasant, winner of the two-mile run last year, will be back to compete in the mile. His best time this year is 4:13.

Twelve sprinters have recorded times of 9.9 or better in 100-yard dash. They include Green of Cubberley, Guthrie of Cupertino, Rod Dawkins of Mt. Pleasant and Wallace Bernard of Galileo.

Los Altos high jumper Bill Graber will defend his '77 title against some stiff opposition in Doug Wright of Live Oak (6-8) and Joel Wyrick of Mt. Pleasant (6-8), among others. Graber's best is 6-9½.

Top entrees in the discus look to be Carl Ezerski of Cupertino (171-0), Mike Niland of Riordan (171-0) and Regan Avery of Menlo-Atherton (165-0).

Kiwanis Relays

Scots show their heels at Foothill

If there was any doubt about Carlmont High having the Central Coast Section's top track team, a lot of it was erased Saturday.

The Scots blitzed a 62-school field at the 17th annual Kiwanis Invitational track and field meet at Foothill College, amassing 53 points to runnerup Mount Pleasant's 24½. Pittsburg was third with 24 points.

Carlmont nabbed three third-place awards and took first and second in the all-important relays,

although the Scots didn't grab any individual firsts.

Five Midpeninsula performers earned first-place laurels—miler Kobert Smith of Awalt, discus thrower Steve Struble of Sunnyvale, hurdler Malcolm Dixon of Sequoia, long jumper Steve Finley of Cupertino and pole vaulter Mitch Preciado of Homestead.

Smith, who turned in a 4:29.7 mile in a dual meet Thursday, lowered his time by nearly 10 seconds to nip Cupertino's Dave Avila, 4:19.9 to 4:20.6.

Struble, with a lifetime best of 177 feet in the discus, didn't approach that mark but still unleashed a 170-2 toss to surpass second-place Carl Ezerski of Cupertino, who managed a 163-8 flip.

Dixon, expected to run into trouble against a competitive field in the high hurdles, showed his foes nothing but heel. The closest anybody came to his 14.2 clocking was a 15.0 by Cupertino's Steve Guthrie.

The Cherokee speedster came within one tenth of a second of

equalling the meet record set by Carl Florant of Palo Alto in 1973.

Finley's long jump of 21-11¾ was almost seven inches better than the second-place distance. The All-De Anza Athletic League football end has a 23-foot leap under his belt.

Preciado, who entered competition with a 14-8 pole vault best compared to 15-4 for Del Mar's Bert Tardieu, deadlocked Tardieu at 15 feet and was awarded the triumph on the basis of fewer misses.

Green was nosed out for the 440 title by one tenth of a second, 49.4 to 49.5, and then blazed to a 9.8 clocking in the 100—only to be beaten by a meet record 9.6 by Pittsburg's Raymond Threatt and another 9.8 by Overfelt's Duane Taylor.
