

Curran Vaults 17-1, Sets CIF Masters Mark

Anthony Curran of Crespi and Greg Ernst of El Dorado had been billed as the main event in Friday night's CIF Masters track and field meet at Arcadia High School, and the high-flying pole vaulters did not disappoint the crowd of 5,000.

Curran, the national interscholastic record-holder at 17-4¼, missed three times at 17-5¼ but did establish a CIF record at 17-1.

Ernst cleared 16-6 which erased his own CIF record of 16-5½ on his second try after Curran had made it, then failed to negotiate 17-1.

Curran opened at 15-6 and didn't miss until 17-1, which he cleared on his second attempt.

"I felt good coming in," said Curran, who had suffered a groin pull two weeks ago and again last Saturday. "I jumped 17 in practice two days ago. I hadn't done that in two weeks."

Asked if he was saving his best for the State meet in Bakersfield next Friday and Saturday (the first five finishers in each event qualify), Curran replied, "I gave it everything I had tonight."

A few feet away, another drama had been building in the boys' high jump.

The spotlight was centered on Del-

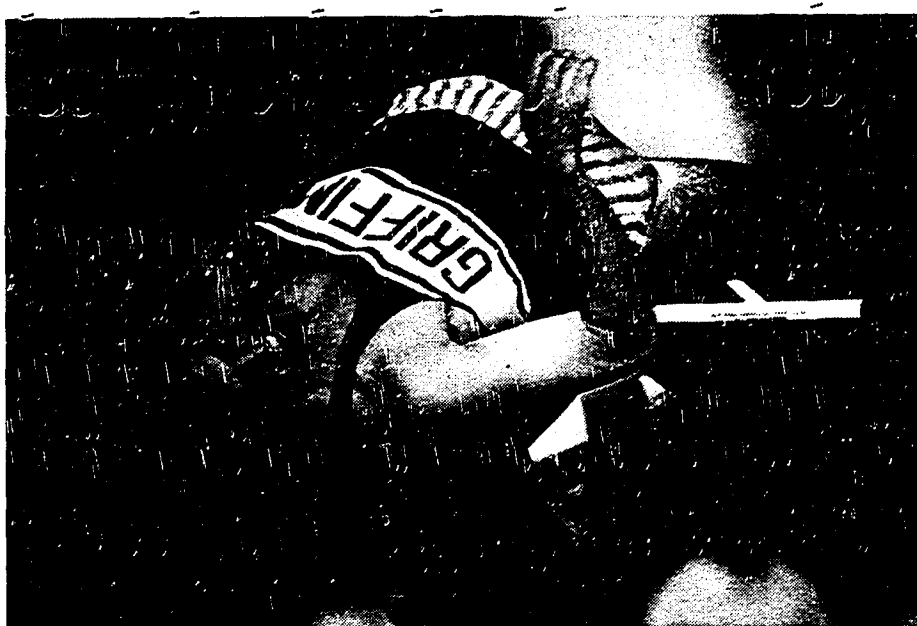
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RECORD SPIN—Christi Pyle of Hoover whirls in the ring before unleashing throw of 158-4 to set CIF girls record in the discus Friday during

CURRAN CLEARS 17-1

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von Davis of Miraleste as he approached the CIF record of 7-0½, set by Dennis Smith of Santa Monica last year. Davis finally made 7-0 on his third effort, but was unsuccessful at 7-1. His previous best was 6-10.

Ron Bahara of Hart ran the fastest high school mile in the nation this year, 4:09.2, taking the lead from Hemet's Mark Fricker on the final turn.

In the girls' mile, Sharon Hulse of Edison also turned in a spectacular time (4:50.7), fastest in the state this season.

Pasadena established itself as a favorite in the State meet by qualifying in eight events, and the leading qualifier among the girls was Thousand Oaks with five.

The girls got off to an impressive start when Christi Pyle of Hoover set a CIF record in the opening event, tossing the discus 158 feet 4 inches.

"It's fun when you do your best," she said. "I was really pleased. Big meets always psyche me up."

Pyle, a senior who plans to attend Cal State Northridge in the fall, broke her own mark of 146-9, set in last week's qualifying meet.

Susie Meek of Palos Verdes also erased her own CIF record in the two-mile run with a clocking of 10:34.6, more than 10 seconds faster than last week (10:44.8).

The smooth-striding Meek figures to provide strong competition in the State championships for Shari Williams of Livermore, the probable favorite. Williams' best is 10:37.5.

Kerry Zwart of Crescenta Valley won the girls' shotput with a toss of 45-7, another CIF record. She also finished second in the long jump at 17-6.

One of the loudest groans from the crowd occurred during the boys 440 relay, when Santa Ana Valley, one of the pre-race favorites, was eliminated on the first pass. Tony Pitts handed the baton to William Steen, who dropped it, and Pasadena went on to win.

"I gave it to him and he just let it go," Pitts said. "I don't know what happened."

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1978 TRACK AND FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

A SUCCESS AS EIGHT CHAMPIONS CROWNED

It came down to the mile relay and Muir had to finish three places ahead of Pasadena to win the Boys' 4A track championship in the first ever CIF-SS all-divisional track and field championships held at Arcadia High School.

Tony Wells of Muir got the baton on the last leg of the relay in fourth place and moved into second place while Pasadena was unable to improve on its sixth place thus giving Muir the title with 54 points. Pasadena finished second with 51.

Other divisional winners were Garey in the 3A, Cajon — 2A and Los Angeles Lutheran a repeat winner in the 1A.

The Girls' 4A crown went to Crescenta Valley, a narrow winner over

Thousand Oaks and Muir. Crescenta Valley finished with 27 points while Thousand Oaks and Muir tied for second with 26.

The Garey girls' won the 3A championship to make it two for the day, while Cajon of Anaheim successfully defended the 2A title they won last year. The 1A Championship went to Orange Lutheran.

It was a day of records and Anthony Curran of Crespi and Greg Ernst of El Dorado both cleared 16-5½ in the pole vault to break the CIF-SS mark at 16-4½ held by Steve Smith of South Torrance in 1969 and Tim Hintnaus of Aviation in 1976.

In girls' competition eight CIF-SS records were set.

Individual State Champions from the Southern Section were Anthony Curran (Crespi) in the pole vault at 17-5; Mike Sanford (Pasadena) 100 yd dash 9.85; and 220 21.42; Jeff Nelson (Burbank) 2-mile 8:59.28; Milan Stewart (West Covina) 120 HH 13.97; Brad Harris (Los Alamito) High Jump 6-11; and Charles Allen (LB Poly) 330 LH 36.58.

Girls' state titles went to Christy Pyle (Hoover) Discus 149-3; Kerry Swart (Crescenta Valley) shot put 45-11½; Arlise Emerson (Westminster) 440 54.3.

The performances by Curran and Emerson established new state meet records.

Crespi's Currans star; Lutheran captures 'A' title

Running in four events, Crespi High School's Willie Curran scored victories in half of them to highlight Valley performances in the CIF, Southern Section track and field finals Saturday at Arcadia High School.

All four CIF divisions were run Saturday.

Curran breezed to a comfortable win in the 330-yard low hurdles in 37.58 and used a late charge to post a narrow win in the 200 in 22.47.

Both marks were far off Willie's season bests, however.

To make it a diverse afternoon, Curran went unplaced in the 100 and was unable to break the Celtic 440 relay team back into contention after receiving the baton in anchor position far behind the leaders.

Crespi's relay team finished seventh in 43.8.

Teammate Anthony Curran

turned in an outstanding effort in the pole vault, clearing 16-5½ on his third try to break the CIF record of 16-4½.

Competing in a different division, El Dorado's Greg Ernst also cleared 16-5½.

Taking the lead from the unrelated Currans, Crespi finished third in the "AAAA" division team standings with 44 points.

Garay won the "AAA" crown with 63 points and West Covina placed with 45.

Notre Dame scored 24 points.

Lutheran of Burbank captured the "A" title with 48 points, shading Lutheran of Orange, which had 47.

Carpinteria and Barstow were third and fourth with 42 and 40 points, respectively.

The "AAAA" division was won by Muir with 54 points.

Second was Pasadena with 51.

Cajon was the runaway winner

in the "AA" division, scoring 47 points.

The top nine individuals in each event — based solely on best times and distances — will advance to the CIF Masters Meet next Friday.

In other Valley-area highlights Saturday:

•Hart's Ron Bahara was the easy winner in the "AAA" division mile with a time of 4:12.0., upsetting favorite Buirt Shirley of Notre Dame, who clocked 4:17.1.

Bahara took command on the final lap and never was challenged.

•Ray Knerr of Simi Valley placed second in the "AAAA" mile with an impressive time of 4:18.82. Eisenhower's Frank Assumma was the winner in 4:16.29.
