events. Skies cleared after some mid-morning sprinkles and the track was damp but firm.

Skinner, a 29-year-old service veteran who left Tennessee because the coach refused to let him on the team with a mustache, competed for the New York Athletic Club yesterday. His effort bettered the previous 1971 best of 273-1 by Larry Stuart of the Southern California Striders.

Frenn, a former Long Beach State weight man, went slightly over the season's previous U.S. mark of 224-6 by Al Schoterman of Kent State.

Two world record holders, Jay Silvester in the discus and Ralph Mann in the 440 intermediate hurdles, also won easily in early events. Silvester had

a throw of 204-1 and Mann, from Brigham Young University, took the hurdles in 50.7 over the slow track.

Defending AAU decathlon champion John Warkentin of Fresno, recovering from a month-long illness, won the pentathlon with 3424 points for the five events.
